WHEREAS, we need to remind the younger generations that our many freedoms came only at a price, that were it not for the brave, there would not be a land of the free; and




WHEREAS; on September 2, 1945, church bells rang, special Thanksgiving prayers were offered, veterans were honored and the fallen were remembered; and
