Section I. That the Amended and Restated Solid Waste Disposal System Agreement is hereby amended by deleting Section II-2 in its entirety and substituting there the following new Section II-2:

Section II-2. <u>Composition of the Board</u>. The Board shall be comprised of eight (8) members, three of whom shall be appointed by the Hamblen County Commission, three of whom shall be appointed by the City Council of the City of Morristown, one of whom will be appointed by the County Executive, subject to confirmation by the Hamblen County Commission and one of whom shall be appointed from among the Mayor and members of City Council, such member of the governing body shall be appointed by the City Administrator, subject to confirmation by the City Council of the City of Morristown.

In the event that the appointee for the board position to be filled from among the Mayor and members of City Council shall fail to receive confirmation by City Council for a period of ninety days from the date of said appointment, and the seat is not filled by appointment and confirmation from among the Mayor and members of City Council within said ninety day period, the City Administrator shall forthwith make the appointment from other than among the Mayor and members of City Council, which appointment shall be subject to confirmation by the governing body.

Section II. That a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the County Legislative Body for confirmation.
