# A RESOLUTION TO AMEND SECTION 6.11 ACCESSORY BUILDINGS, HAMBLEN COUNTY ZONING RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Hamblen County Planning Commission has recognized the need for an amendment to Section 6.11 Accessory Building Regulations/Restrictions; and,

WHEREAS, The Hamblen County Planning Commission does hereby recommend to the Hamblen County Board of Commissioners that Section 6.11 Part A be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

All accessory buildings shall be located in the rear or side of the tract/lot unless the tract or lot is over three acres in which case the accessory building can be located anywhere on the lot. No accessory building on tracts/lots less than three acres shall be greater than 25 percent of the rear year as measured ten feet from rear of existing structure, ten feet from both sides and rear lot lines. For properties that have no structure, the accessory building shall be deemed the principle structure and shall meet all setback requirements of the principle structure. Location of utility lines and/or septic field and duplicate lines shall be the responsibility of the owner and submitted with the application for a building permit. No accessory buildings shall be placed over utility or field lines. A site plan shall be submitted for all accessory buildings; however, a site plan for an accessory building on a lot over three acres shall be submitted to the planning commission for review and approval. No variances will be permitted on any accessory buildings regarding size of building, location or setbacks.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Hamblen County Board of Commissioners that Section 6.11 Part A, Accessory buildings, be adopted as recommended by the planning commission as written above.

# A RESOLUTION TO REPEAL THE EXISTING SECTION 6.11C AND REPLACE WITH A NEW SECTION 6.11 C MEDICAL HARDSHIP, HAMBLEN COUNTY ZONING RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Hamblen County Planning Commission has recognized the need for an amendment to the Hamblen County Zoning Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, The Hamblen County Planning Commission does hereby recommend to the Hamblen County Board of Commissioners that Section 6.11C replace as it reads below the existing section 6.11C:

### 6.11 C Medical Hardship

The purpose of granting a medical hardship is to provide an individual with quality care that would otherwise require a long term nursing home stay or hospice. The medical hardship must be life threatening or require constant remedial care after surgery or other serious health issues. The following conditions must be met:

- 1. The granting of a medical hardship allows a second dwelling to be placed on the property only if the primary residence is legal. The secondary residence must be a single wide, double wide or "granny pod" that meets current building codes. All zoning setbacks must be met or the second dwelling shall not be allowed. The second dwelling shall be served by public water and sewer or septic system. If a septic system is to be used, the lot must have an additional evaluation to determine if an additional septic system and duplicate area can be utilized on the property. This second system must be certified by the health department.
- 2. The second dwelling must be used exclusively to house an immediate family member that includes either a: great grandparent, grandparent, parent, sibling or adult child.
- 3. A family member must be needed to assist with the constant and reoccurring physical care. The family member must live either in the primary residence or the secondary structure.

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- 4. The medical hardship must be life threatening such as: cancer, end stage renal failure, stroke, heart condition, ALS, Muscular Dystrophy or any similar disease. The applicant must have a letter from the attending physician(s) on official letterhead stating the medical issue and the length of time needed for the care. The letter must be submitted annually to the Board of Zoning Appeals.
- 5. The Board of Zoning Appeals shall hear the application for medical hardship from each applicant once a year. The medical hardship approval may be continued on a yearly basis as long as all of the conditions described in this paragraph continue to exist. Once the conditions authorized no longer exist or no annual paperwork and proof of medical hardship supporting the continuation has been submitted for the required annual hearing, the permit shall be deemed expired and the secondary structure must be removed within sixty (60) days. If the structure is not removed and legal action is required, the County will seek the recouping of all legal fees including court costs and attorney fees.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Hamblen County Board of Commissioners that Section 6.11C of the Hamblen County Zoning Resolution be amended as recommended by the planning commission and written above.

# A RESOLUTION TO AMEND ARTICLE 10-ADMINISTRATION 10.2 PERMIT REQUIREMENTS, HAMBLEN COUNTY ZONING RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Hamblen County Planning Commission has recognized the need for an amendment to Section 10.2 Permit Requirements; and

WHEREAS, The Hamblen County Planning Commission does hereby recommend to the Hamblen County Board of Commissioners that the following be added to Section 10.2

If a residence is occupied before the final inspection is completed, Hamblen County will not issue a Certificate of Occupancy. However, if the property owner provides the Planning Commission office with a certificate from a state licensed structural engineer saying that the building is structurally sound, the Planning Commission office will recognize that the evaluation was done and attach the report from the engineer to the building permit.

In a case that no building permit was issued and the property owner did not follow the proper building inspection process, the property owner can provide the Planning Commission office with a certificate from a state licensed structural engineer saying that the building is structurally sound the Planning Commission office will acknowledge that the structural assessment has taken place. No building permit or certificate of occupancy will be issued.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Hamblen County Legislative Body does hereby amend the Hamblen County Zoning Resolution to read as follows:

10.2 Permits Requirements. (Jan. 21, 2010) It shall be unlawful to erect, construct, place, enlarge, alter, move, or change the occupancy of a principal building, structure or accessory building on any lot, tract, parcel or plot of land, unless exempted from permit requirements, before the required building permit is obtained. It shall also be unlawful to construct a second principal structure on any single piece of property, or to make any additions or alterations to any existing building or structure, unless the proper approval and permit is first obtained. A building permit is not required for conducting ordinary repairs and maintenance activities to buildings or structures not involving the cutting away of any wall, the removal or cutting of any structural beam or load-bearing support, or any changes made to ingress or egress requirements. Exemptions from the permit requirements of the adopted codes shall not be deemed to grant authorization for any work or maintenance activity to be done in violation of the provisions of such codes or any other laws of this state or resolutions of this jurisdiction.

A building permit is required for the placement of a modular home or structure and the placement, replacement or upgrading of a manufactured (mobile) home, or other similar type of mobile unit which is approved under Article 6.11 C., either temporarily or permanently. The storage of a mobile home anywhere other than in an approved mobile home park or on a mobile home sales lot is strictly prohibited.

It shall be unlawful to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any mechanical, plumbing or gas system, the installation of which is regulated by adopted codes, or to cause such work to be done, unless exempted, without first obtaining the required permits for the work. Mechanical, plumbing, and gas permits shall not be required for minor repair work, direct

replacement of an existing system or components or ordinary maintenance activities conducted on an existing mechanical, plumbing or gas systems. Exemption from the permit requirements of the adopted codes shall not be deemed to grant authorization for any work, replacement or maintenance activity to be done in violation of the provisions of such codes or any other laws of this State or resolutions of this jurisdiction.

It shall be unlawful to commence any land-disturbance activity that would require the uncovering of one acre, or more, without first receiving the approval and obtaining a general construction permit from the State of Tennessee and submitting an Erosion and Sediment Control Plan to the County, for its approval, and obtaining a local site development permit.

Unless otherwise provided, owners/agents of project developments of less than one acre of land-disturbance are required to obtain authorization under a local storm water permit when the construction activities at the site are either: (1) part of a larger common development or sale that is at least one acre in size; (2) discharges from the site are causing, contributing to, or are likely to cause local storm water violations; (3) discharges from the site are, or are likely to be a significant contributor of pollutants to waters of the State; or (4) local, state or federal laws or rules require such sites to obtain a permit.

In addition to any other provisions in this Resolution, the commencement, placement or modification made to any site, building, structure or system without first obtaining the required permit(s) shall subject the owner/agent to double permit fee(s). Also, failure to obtain any of the necessary inspections either before, during or after the course of site development or construction activity may require an engineer's certification on the site, building, structure or system to verify compliance with applicable laws, resolutions and adopted code provisions.

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#### 10.0 LONGEVITY PAY

Eligible Hamblen County employees are entitled to receive longevity pay. To be eligible to receive longevity pay, an employee must meet the following requirements:

- Occupy a regular full-time position within Hamblen County Government that qualifies the employee for other county employment benefits, i.e. health insurance, life insurance, retirement, vacation and sick leave;
- Have accrued at least three (3) years of **regular** full-time employment within Hamblen County Government;
- Apply and be approved for the longevity payment by the County Commission's Personnel Committee

Temporary, casual or part-time employees, department heads and elected officials whose minimum salaries are set by the state legislature are <u>ineligible</u> to receive longevity pay. Time spent working in a part-time position is <u>not</u> included in the eligibility calculation for longevity pay. Employees whose full-time work history within Hamblen County Government (HCG) is interrupted will receive credit for all previous full-time employment. For instance, if an employee works 18 months for a county department and leaves employment (and is not terminated for cause) for a period of time, that employee will receive credit for the 18 months toward the three (3) year eligibility requirement if he/she returns to work for HCG.

Employees must complete an application (available from the Human Resources Manager) to qualify for longevity pay. The application will be reviewed by the County Commission's Personnel Committee which will either approve or deny the application. Employees should allow 30 days for their applications to be processed. If an application is denied the applicant can request an appeals hearing before the Personnel Committee.

Full-time employees who qualify for longevity pay will receive \$75 per year of service not to exceed \$2,250. The longevity pay will be paid annually with the last pay check of the employee's anniversary month. Longevity pay will be administered as a lump sum payment with the applicable payroll taxes and retirement contribution deducted and will not become part of the employee's base pay.

Longevity pay will not be included on a pro-rated basis when end of employment or termination pay is calculated. An employee must be an active employee on his/her anniversary date to receive the longevity pay for that year.

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### Health and Wellness Incentive

Proposed Change to HRA Wellness Program

The federal Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) has ruled that employer sponsored health insurance plans, like the County's plan, can no longer offer lower deductible limits as an incentive for participating in a wellness program.

This decision means that beginning with the 2018 plan year the Hamblen County Health Insurance Plan can no longer offer a lower deductible (\$1,250 vs \$2,000) for employees/spouses who complete a Health Risk Assessment (HRA) each year. Presently, 82% of county employees and/or their dependents participate in the HRA wellness program.

Therefore, I am proposing that the County change its health insurance premium structure to encourage employees/spouses to participate in the HRA wellness program. The proposal includes an additional \$50/month for employees without dependent coverage or with employee/children coverage if they do NOT complete a HRA and an additional \$100/month for employees with spouse/family coverage if they do NOT complete a HRA. Children are not required to complete a HRA for them to be compliant. Under this proposal, the deductible for all participants will be \$1,250 per person and \$2,500 for family coverage regardless of whether they participate with the HRA Wellness Program.

If approved, the additional premium would be effective with the December 15, 2017 payroll. The deadline to complete HRA's would be September 30, 2017.

Participating in the HRA wellness program is a critical part of managing our self-insured health insurance plan, because it gives the employees, their families and the health care providers the information they need to better manage their health and health care.

The proposal will be presented to the Personnel Committee at its meeting on Monday, July 10, 2017.

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## E-911 Health Insurance

Hamblen County had an actuarial study of its employee health insurance plan performed recently. It confirmed what we had suspected that since the start of the self-insured plan three years ago, the County has subsidized the payment of claims for E-911 employees by more than \$300,000.

The health insurance plan has sustained the losses from the 911 group without raising premiums for all members of the health plan, but the plan can no longer sustain it. The study suggested three ways to address the issue which included significant premium adjustments for 911 participants that could range from 30 to 67 percent plus an end-of-the-year reconciliation between revenue and expenses (claims/administrative expenses) for 911 employees.

Therefore, I am proposing a three-step solution that, in my opinion, would be the least painful for the ECD.

- STEP 1: Premiums charged 911 for its employees and dependents increase 15% effective July 2017.
- STEP 2: The District reimburses the self-insurance fund \$50,000 over the next six months to offset some of the shortfall incurred over the last three years.
- STEP 3: The District transitions off the County's health insurance plan effective
  January 1, 2018. The County and its health insurance consultant will help find
  an affordable plan that meets the District's needs. A preliminary search indicates
  that the District qualifies to participate in the State of Tennessee's Local
  Government Health Insurance Plan. The state plan's premium structure is attached.

The future of ECD's eligibility for the Hamblen County-City of Morristown Employee Health Clinic will be discussed by the clinic management team.

The County is committed to making this transition as smooth as possible, and welcomes input from the ECD Board.

In July 2016, the County Commission approved a policy allowing pre-65 year old retirees from E-911, Morristown-Hamblen Library and Hamblen-Morristown Solid Waste Authority the option to participate with Hamblen County's health insurance plan if the retirees were willing to pay the full premium and with the understanding that their dependents would not be eligible for coverage. Currently, we do not have any retirees from these outside agencies enrolled in our health insurance plan as a result of this policy.

I am requesting that we rescind this policy while the County Mayor's office and Finance Department work with our health insurance consultant, Sherrill Morgan, on a strategic plan for our self-insured health insurance plan going forward. For approximately the last six months, we have been discussing possible strategies with Sherrill Morgan and will be prepared to present them to the personnel committee within 60 days.
