RESOLUTION TO PETITION THE U. S. CONGRESS
TO HALT THE PRACTICE OF ENACTING UNFUNDED
FEDERAL MANDATES FOR CITIES AND COUNTIES
IN AMERICA

WHEREAS, unfunded federal mandates are a threat to the vitality and financial stability of cities and counties across Tennessee and America; and

WHEREAS, legislation is pending to halt this practice - particularly Senate Bill 993, by Senator Dirk Kempthorne and co-sponsored by Senator Harlan Mathews; and

WHEREAS, hearings should be held by Congress on this issue.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Hamblen County, Tennessee, Board of County Commissioners, that Hamblen County supports legislation such as Senate Bill 993 to halt unfunded federal mandates.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that our Senators and members of Congress are urged to cosponsor this legislation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Clerk be authorized and directed to send a copy of this resolution to our Senators and Congressmen as well as Senator Dirk Kempthorne of Idaho.
