ARTICLE III C.1 <u>ARRANGEMENT</u>. Insofar as practical, side lot lines shall be ar right angles to straight street lines or radio to curved street lines. Each lot must front for a minimum of fifty (50) feet upon a public street or road except in special instances, such as cul-de-sacs; in which case each lot must have frontage of at least forty (40) feet. In the event that a parcel or tract of land has less than one hundred (100) feet but eighty (80) or more feet frontage on a public street or road and is therefore incapable of being subdivided under these regulations then, and in that event, a subdivision of such parcel of land will be allowed so long as each of the remaining lots, after sub-division, has at least forty (40) feet frontage on a public street or road.
