

**WHEREAS,** The Hamblen County Planning Commission has reviewed and recommended the rewriting of Article 6.5 Public Road Frontage Required to replace the existing Article 6.5 section of the Hamblen County Zoning Resolution; and,

**WHEREAS,** The Hamblen County Board of Commissioners has held a public hearing on \_\_\_\_\_ and advertised the proposed amendment on \_\_\_\_\_;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Hamblen County Board of Commissioners do hereby adopt the following Article 6.5 Public Road Frontage Required as a replacement for the existing section:

**6.5 PUBLIC ROAD FRONTAGE REQUIRED.** No construction may be permitted on a lot or tract which does not abut a public road for a minimum of fifty (50) feet. ~~In the event that a tract or parcel of land has been subdivided pursuant to Article III C.1 of the Hamblen County Subdivision Regulations which under certain circumstances will permit the creation of two lots out of one parcel, each with a minimum of forty (40) feet frontage on a public street or road, and is therefore incapable of being further subdivided under Article III C.1 of the Hamblen County Subdivision Regulations, then and in that event, construction may be permitted on such lots having a minimum of forty (40) feet frontage on such public road or street.~~ Subdivided property must meet the requirement of the Hamblen County Subdivision Regulations.





A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS OF  
HAMBLÉN COUNTY BY THE SUBSTITUTION OF ARTICLE III C.1  
ARRANGEMENT TO REPLACE THE  
CURRENT ARTICLE III C.1.**

**WHEREAS,** The Hamblen County Planning Commission has reviewed and recommended the rewriting of Article III. C.1 Arrangement to replace the existing Article III C.1 section of the Hamblen County Subdivision Regulations; and,

**WHEREAS,** The Hamblen County Board of Commissioners has held a public hearing on \_\_\_\_\_ and advertised the proposed amendment on \_\_\_\_\_;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Hamblen County Board of Commissioners do hereby adopt the following Article III C.1 Arrangement as a replacement for the existing section:

**ARTICLE III C.1 ARRANGEMENT.** Insofar as practical, side lot lines shall be at right angles to straight street lines or radio to curved street lines. Each lot must front for a minimum of fifty (50) feet upon a public street or road except in special instances, such as cul-de-sacs; in which case each lot must have frontage of at least forty (40) feet. In the event that a parcel or tract of land has less than one hundred (100) feet but eighty (80) or more feet frontage on a public street or road and is therefore incapable of being subdivided under these regulations then, and in that event, a subdivision of such parcel of land will be allowed so long as each of the remaining lots, after subdivision, has at least forty (40) feet frontage on a public street or road.


