THE TENNESSEE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO  
RECONSIDER PROPOSED BUDGET CUTS FOR THE  
TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS**

**WHEREAS**, Hamblen County has a population of 5,353 veterans residing in the County, and

**WHEREAS**, The total expenditures by the Tennessee Department of Veterans Affairs in Hamblen County for fiscal year 1997-98 is estimated to be \$4,999,624.00 for benefits and services, and

**WHEREAS**, A reduction in funding by the State of Tennessee for the Department of Veterans Affairs has severely impacted services that were available to our local veterans, who have given a significant part of their lives in service and protection to their County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE HAMBLLEN COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY**, meeting in regular session, this the 19th day of March, 1998, that

**SECTION 1.** The Governor of the State of Tennessee, and the Members of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee are hereby encouraged to restore the funding level of the Tennessee Department of Veterans Affairs, and to reconsider any proposed budget reductions for the upcoming fiscal year.

**SECTION 2.** That copies of the Resolution be mailed to the Tennessee Department of Veterans Affairs Office in Nashville, the Governor of the State of Tennessee, and the Representatives of Hamblen County in the Tennessee General Assembly.

**SECTION 3.** That, upon passage, this Resolution be spread upon the minutes of the Hamblen County Board of Commissioners, the public welfare requiring it.
