THIS REAL ESTATE CONSULTING AGREEMENT (hereinafter "Agreement") is made this 1st day of May, 2016, by and between Hamblen County, Tennessee (the "County") and Lebel Commercial Realty (the "Consultant").

### BACKGROUND:

- a. The County desires to retain the Consultant to provide certain real estate consulting services, and is of the opinion that Consultant has the necessary qualifications, experience, and abilities to provide such services to the County.
- b. The Consultant desires to provide certain real estate consulting services to the County in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual benefits and obligations set forth in this Agreement, the receipt and sufficiency of which consideration is hereby acknowledged, County and Consultant agree as follows:

### Services Provided

- 1. The County hereby agrees to retain the Consultant to provide the County with real estate consulting services (hereinafter "Services") related to a) the search for property for needs that may arise; b) the negotiation for the purchase and/or lease of identified property; and c) assistance with the process of closing the purchase and/or lease of identified property. The Consultant shall provide such real estate consulting services as reasonably requested by the County during the term of this Agreement, provided that nothing here within shall require the Consultant to devote a minimum number of hours per week to the performance of services herein.
- 2. Services will also include any other tasks that the County and the Consultant both mutual agree on.

### **Terms of Agreement**

- 3. The term of this agreement will begin on the date of this Agreement and will remain in full force and effect until April 30, 2018.
- 4. Services shall be performed at the request of the County Mayor and/or the Chairman of the County Commission. A scope of work agreement must be signed by the County Mayor and the Consultant before billable hours can begin.
- 5. The Consultant shall provide a certificate of insurance which shall insure County against any errors or omissions of Consultant which might result in a claim or claims against County due to any act or failure to act of Consultant in connection with services provided hereunder. Consultant's production of a certificate of such

insurance in an amount not less than one million (\$1,000,000) shall be a precondition of Consultant's providing services hereunder.

- 6. The County acknowledges and takes full responsibility and maintains control of all conclusions and decisions made as a result of the services provided by the Consultant. The County acknowledges that the Consultant cannot control future events, and therefore, cannot be responsible for long-term outcomes of budget or financial strategies.
- 7. This Agreement shall be for a time period specified by and agreed to by both parties. Cancellation of the Agreement requires written notification by the requesting party not less than 30 days in advance of cancellation unless it is determined by the County or the Consultant that a direct or indirect conflict of interest exists. If so, this Agreement will be terminated immediately without prejudice.
- 8. Under certain circumstances, brokers can have a conflict in the representation of two parties. If a professional conflict of interest arises involving lead broker Paul LeBel, LeBel Commercial Realty will assign broker Will Sliger to represent the County.
- 9. County acknowledges that the Consultant is an independent contractor and is NOT considered an employee of the County. Consultant acknowledges that it is an independent contractor and has no expectations to be treated as an employee.
- 10. Hamblen County's Request for Qualifications/Proposals for Real Estate Agent Services and LeBel Commercial Realty's response are part of this consulting agreement.

### **Performance**

11. Both parties agree to do everything necessary to ensure that the terms of this Agreement take effect.

### Compensation

12. For the services rendered by the Consultant, the Consultant will be compensated on a case by case basis depending on the scope of work. The Consultant may be paid a commission fee by the Seller/Landlord if a property transaction takes place. If the County is responsible for paying the fee, it may be a percent of the transaction amount or an hourly rate depending on the scope of work agreed upon by the Consultant and the County Mayor before work begins. The percentage fee, to be divided among the realtors involved, will be 7% for transactions below \$300,000 and 5% for transactions at or above \$300,000. The hourly fee is \$130 per hour. The hourly rate will be used for consulting duties that do not involve property transactions, such as negotiating lease agreements. For work compensated by the hourly rate, the Consultant shall submit an invoice for payment on a monthly basis that will be paid by the fifteenth of the subsequent month. ## COMMERCIAL LEASE FOR COUNTY CLERK SATELLIN OFFICE OF THE HAMBLEN COUNTY MAYOR

THIS COMMERCIAL LEASE is hereby made and entered into this 20th day of May, 2016 by and between Mark L. Sawyer ("Landlord") and Hamblen County, a political subdivision of the State of Tennessee ("Tenant").

### WITNESSETH:

For and in consideration of the rental, undertakings and mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, Landlord hereby leases to Tenant, and Tenant hereby leases from Landlord, subject to the terms and conditions hereafter expressed, certain office space more particularly described and located within the Landlord's real estate described as:

### Street Address: 2415 N Davy Crockett Parkway, Morristown, Tennessee, 37814

The "Leased Premises" shall be three thousand three hundred sixty (3,360) square feet interior office suites located in the building formerly housing Epes Transport Systems. Further included in the leased premises is the use of the parking area surrounding the landlord's building.

The covenants and conditions of this Lease are as follows:

1. Term: This Lease shall commence on June 1, 2016 and end on May 31, 2017 (the "Initial Term"). Tenant shall have the option to renew the Lease for an additional one (1) year term (the "Renewal Term") by providing Landlord with written notice of its desire to exercise this option as least sixty (60) days prior to the end of the Initial Term.

Landlord shall have the right within the last sixty (60) days of the Initial Term or within the last sixty (60) days of the Renewal Term to show the Leased Premises to prospective tenants.

2. Rent: Landlord agrees to charge \$1,100 per month rent for the Leased Premises during the Initial Term. Should the Tenant exercise the option to renew the Lease for an additional one (1) year, the rent amount will be \$1,850 per month beginning with the first day of June 2017 for a total of twelve (12) months.

The Tenant agrees to pay to the Landlord during the Initial Term an amount equal to the 2016 Hamblen County and City of Morristown property taxes for the office space and one-half acre of land based on the assessed value on file in the Hamblen County Assessor of Property's office. During the renewal period, the amount to be paid to the Landlord will be an amount equal to the 2017 property taxes for the City of Morristown and Hamblen County. The Tenant is exempt from personal property taxes.

3. Build Out Provisions: Tenant will contract for and pay for the renovation of the office space. The renovation will include installing two interior walls (with doors), a removal of one wall, partial ceiling replacement, new flooring and paint, electrical outlets, replacement door and two (2) overhead lights.

- 4. Alterations and Improvements: All additions and improvements made in and upon the Leased Premises, either by Tenant or Landlord, shall be the Landlord's sole property or shall remain upon the Leased Premises at the termination of this Lease, without compensation to the Tenant.
- 5. Maintenance and Repair: Tenant agrees to maintain the Leased Premises in the same general condition as when received, ordinary wear and tear and damage by the elements excepted. Tenant also agrees to keep the Leased Premises free from trash, garbage and other waste.

Tenant agrees to pay Landlord, upon demand, for any and all loss or damage to the Leased Premises caused by Tenant's misuse, waste, or neglect or caused by any of Tenant's employees, agents, clients, visitors or anyone else invited by or under the control of Tenant again, normal wear and tear excepted.

Tenant shall not allow any unlawful activities to take place upon the Leased Premises.

Tenant shall promptly notify Landlord of any accident to or defect in the water pipes, sewer pipes, gas pipes, electric wiring, heating or air conditioning systems or fixtures. It is agreed that Landlord shall not in any case be liable in damages for any temporary breakdown of said facilities or discontinuance of services provided by such facilities. Tenant agrees to take all reasonable steps to protect the plumbing during freezing weather.

Plumbing repairs and ordinary maintenance shall be the responsibility of the Tenant. Repairs will include the cost of backup of services and drains from fixtures within the Leased Premises. The cost of such service and repair from "backup" will be the sole expense of the Tenant.

Tenant is responsible for all HVAC issues, maintenance of all fixtures and components and replacement of any such fixtures and components as long as the contract is active.

Tenant shall be responsible for all janitorial service, supplies and associated appliances to be used in connection with janitorial services, including paper towel dispensers, paper goods, etc.

Any sign attached to the outside of the building is the responsibility of the Tenant. Such sign must be approved by appropriate municipal authorities and the Landlord. The Landlord agrees to allow Tenant to replace the Parkway Auto Sales sign at the highway so long as the Parkway Auto Sales sign is reinstalled in proper working condition before the Tenant vacates the Leased Premises.

- Utilities and Other Charges: Tenant shall be responsible for arranging for and paying for all 6. electricity, water, telephone, alarm system, gas, internet, and other utility charges for the Leased Premises and the deposits for same.
- 7. Right of Inspection: Landlord shall have the right to enter the Leased Premises at all reasonable hours during the day to inspect the same or to make such repairs and alterations as may be necessary for the safety and preservation of the Leased Premises. Landlord shall make every reasonable effort to notify Tenant of inspections.

8. Insurance Provisions: Landlord shall maintain property and casualty insurance on said property. Tenant shall not use or permit upon the Leased Premises anything that will invalidate any insurance policy now or hereafter in effect on the Leased Premises or that will increase the rate of insurance or cause such insurance to be canceled.

Tenant shall provide his own insurance covering personal property and premises liability with minimum liability limits of \$1,000,000 and shall name Mark L. Sawyer as Additional Insured. A copy of said policy, or acceptable Certificate of Insurance shall be given to Landlord within five (5) business days of inhabiting the premises.

- Landlord Duties: Landlord shall be responsible for all repairs to the structure and roof of the building. Landlord will maintain and clean the exterior of the Building, the grounds and the parking lot. Landlord will support Tenant placing approved signage on the outside of the building if the Tenant chooses.
- 10. Abandonment. If any time during the term of this lease, Tenant abandons the Leased Premises, Landlord may, at his option, enter the Leased Premises by any means without being liable for any prosecution therefore, and without becoming liable to Tenant for damages of any kind whatsoever.
- 11. Damage or Destruction. If, during the Initial Term of this Lease or the Renewal Term, the demised premises shall be or become damaged by fire or by elements, such damage shall be promptly repaired by the Landlord, unless the damage to said premises hereby leased or devised be so great that the same cannot be repaired with reasonable diligence so as to be fit for occupancy. In such event, the rent herein provided to be paid for the said Lease Premises shall abate and be suspended for a period of time from the date of the damage to the Leased Premises hereby leased until the date when the said premises are so repaired as to be ready for occupancy by the Tenant. In such event the tenancy of the Leased Premises hereby leased or demised shall not be terminated, but shall remain in force and effect under and by virtue of the terms and conditions of this Lease, unless the damage done to the Leased Premises hereby leased shall be so great as to make it impossible to repair the premises which the period of ninety (90) days, in which case the Tenant shall have the option of vacating the premises hereby leased or demised and of bringing to an end and terminating this Lease; provided, however, that the said Tenant shall not have such option and shall not be allowed to be relieved from the obligation of this Lease if the damage done to the premises shall in any wise be caused by the intentional act of any agent or representative of the Tenant while acting on behalf of the Tenant.
- 12. If Tenant shall fail to perform or comply with any of the other conditions, terms or agreements in this Lease as set forth herein within thirty (30) days after notice written by Landlord to Tenant specifying the condition to be performed or complied with.

In the event of any default hereunder, Landlord, at any time thereafter, may terminate the Lease at its option and/or re-enter the Leased Premises and expel, remove and put out Tenant

or any person or persons occupying the Leased Premises and remove all personal property there from as allowed by law.

Upon re-entry Landlord may, at its option, release the Leased Premises or any party thereof as the agent of tenant and Tenant shall pay Landlord the difference between the rent herein reserved and imposed for the portion of the term remaining at the time of re-entry and the amount received under such releasing for such portion of the term; additionally, Landlord may also recover from Tenant any other sums (including rents) then due. Landlord may also terminate these Leases and recover from Tenant any sums then due.

Notwithstanding any other provision herein contained, Tenant shall be responsible for all losses (including loss of rents) and damages resulting from any default and/or termination of this Lease. If this Lease is placed in the hands of an attorney, after default or breach, for the enforcement of any rights of Landlord herein, Tenant, agrees to pay all costs of such enforcement or collection, including reasonable attorney's fees.

- 13. Surrender of Premises. At the termination of this Lease, Tenant shall return and surrender the Leased Premises hereby demised without demand of the Landlord in the same condition and properly cleaned, as they were at the time of execution of this Lease, normal wear and tear expected.
- 14. Assignment and Subletting. Landlord agrees to the Tenant subletting 1,860 square feet of office space to the State of Tennessee for use by Administrators of the Courts (AOC). The term of the lease between the Tenant and the State of Tennessee will not extend beyond the term between the Tenant and the Landlord.
- 15. Notice. Any written notice required under this Lease shall be given to Landlord by certified United States mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, at the following address:

The terms and provisions of this Lease are severable such that if any term or provision is declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of proper jurisdictions, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the remaining terms and provision of this Lease, which shall otherwise remain in full force and effect. The entire understanding between the parties is set out in this Lease, this Lease supersedes and voids all prior proposals, letter and agreements, oral or written, and no modification or alteration of this Lease shall be effective unless evidenced by an instrument in writing signed by all parties. This Lease shall be interpreted and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Tennessee.

### I. Introduction and General Information

The purchasing department supports the operations of Hamblen County Government by functioning as the purchasing unit for the procurement of goods, materials, equipment, and services required by the County; and for the disposal of surplus property owned by the County. The purchasing department, a division of the finance department, is created per Article XVIII of the Amended and Restated Hamblen County Government Financial Management System Policies and Procedures, adopted March 19, 2015.

#### a. Purpose of this Manual

The purpose of this manual is to outline and prescribe the policies and procedures in which goods or services must be purchased or disposed of by the County, while ensuring the fair and equitable treatment of vendors who deal with the procurement system of the County. The policies and procedures herein are based on the rules and regulations amended or adopted, and promulgated pursuant to the laws of Hamblen County Government and the applicable laws of the State of Tennessee<sup>1</sup>. The provisions of this Manual shall replace any previous purchasing policies and procedures. Any part of this manual which may conflict with applicable law shall be null and void. If any portion of this Manual is, for any reason, held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Manual.

### b. Application of this Manual

- i. Regulations and procedures set forth in this manual apply to the expenditure of all federal, state, and locally appropriated funds for the procurement of any goods, materials, equipment, and services by the County. All purchases must be for the use or benefit of the County.
- ii. Regulations and procedures set forth in this manual apply to the County's disposition of surplus property, excluding real property.

This manual may be accessed on the County's website. As revisions or additions to this manual become necessary, the purchasing department will post such revisions on the website. If there are any questions concerning this manual, please contact the purchasing manager.

### II. Purchasing Department and Relations with Departments

- a. **Mission.** The mission of the purchasing department is to provide the most cost-effective method of procuring goods, materials, and services for Hamblen County Government while adhering to the procurement laws of Hamblen County Government and the State of Tennessee, as applicable.
- **b.** Objective. The overall objective of the purchasing department is to serve as the County's purchasing unit through which the County and its departments may obtain needed goods or services, via competitive concerns, at competitive costs and in a timely and cost-effective manner.
- c. Purchasing Department. The purchasing department is a division within the County's Finance Department, and is located in the Hamblen County Courthouse, Administrative Building, 511 West Second North Street, Morristown, Tennessee, 37814.
- d. Responsibilities. The purchasing department, which functions as a service for all other departments of the County, will purchase on a competitive basis all goods or services on behalf of each department of the County. The purchasing department must ensure procurements are conducted with integrity, fairness, and openness and in accordance with local and applicable state and federal laws. The purchasing department's responsibilities include, but are not limited to, the following:
  - i. Developing policies and procedures for implementing an economical and efficient purchasing system;
  - ii. Review of all contracts of purchases for biddable supplies, materials, equipment, and other needs of the County;
  - iii. Ensuring that no purchase or contract be made when the bid prices exceed the current market price for the same merchandise or service;
  - iv. Ensuring that purchases and contracts be awarded based on the lowest and/or best bid;
  - v. Review specifications and changes made by departments to allow for maximum competition of prospective bidders;
  - vi. Preparation of formal and informal bids;
  - vii. Collection of sealed bids;
  - viii. Opening of sealed bids through a procedure open to the public;
  - ix. Evaluate, compare, and submit bids for approval by the Legislative Body;
  - x. Issuing purchase orders and contracts;
  - xi. Verification of receipt of merchandise or services;
  - xii. Accept requisitions by the various departments, agency, or official;
  - xiii. Verify budget appropriations before authorizing a purchase and issuing a purchase order;
  - xiv. Provide for emergency purchases, total cost bidding, blanket purchases for small orders, grouping of purchases of the various departments, and other methods for receiving the most competitive price and best bid;

xv. Ensure that emergency purchases be limited to needs arising which are not normally foreseeable, and make known the policy that emergency purchases shall not be permissible if a department or agency fails to properly plan for the need, proper purchasing procedures, and delivery time.

### III. Procurement Method

### a. Biddable Items

- i. "Biddable Items" means any need of the County where more than one (1) bidder or contractor in the County's trade area can provide the material or service. Specifications shall not be written to exclude vendors or contractors or limit the bidding to a specific vendor or contractor.
- ii. Purchases for like items, unless covered by an exemption, estimated to exceed \$9,999.99 in any fiscal year will be competitively bid utilizing a sealed bid procedure<sup>2</sup>. Bid specifications and a suggested vendor distribution list should be provided to the Purchasing Manager by the department making the purchase. The Purchasing Manager will format the specifications into a standard Invitation to Bid. The Purchasing Manager shall solicit sealed bids by public notice inserted at least once in a newspaper of county-wide circulation (i.e., Citizen Tribune), no less than five (5) days prior to the final date for submitting bids. A bid tabulation will be prepared by the Purchasing Manager following the public bid opening. Finance Committee and Legislative Body approval of the best bid is required before a purchase order can be issued. Hamblen County Government reserves the right of accepting and/or rejecting any and/or all bids or parts of bids when doing so serves the best interest of Hamblen County Government.
- iii. A valid State of Tennessee contract may be utilized in lieu of a bid. Quotes from an approved Purchasing Cooperative may be considered as a bid.
- iv. "Piggybacking" may be considered

### **b.** Informal Quotes

- i. Applicable Statute: T.C.A. § 5-14-205
- ii. All purchases, leases or lease-purchase arrangements with expenditures of less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) in any fiscal year may be made in the open market without newspaper notice, but shall, wherever possible, be based upon at least three (3) competitive

quotes. Price, quality of goods/services, and vendor performance will be taken into consideration. In the event the quote that serves the best interest of Hamblen County Government is not the lowest quote, the department head requesting the purchase shall submit a memo with the three (3) price quotes documenting the reasons the chosen vendor was selected.

### c. Emergency Purchases

- i. Applicable Statute: TC.A. § 5-14-204; T.C.A. § 5-21-119
- ii. Emergency purchases shall be limited to needs arising that are not normally foreseeable. Emergency purchases are purchases which are necessary to avert hazards which may threaten health and safety, to protect from damage, or to avoid a major disruption of governmental activities. Emergency purchases shall not be permissible if a department or agency fails to properly plan for the need, proper purchasing procedures, and delivery time.
- iii. A record of any emergency purchase shall be made by the person or body authorizing such emergency purchase, and shall specify the amount paid, the terms purchased, from whom the purchase was made, and the nature of the emergency. A report of any emergency purchase shall be made as soon as possible to the County Legislative Body and the County Mayor, and shall include all items of information as required in the record.

### **IV.** Purchasing Forms

- a. **Purchase Order.** The purchase order is written evidence of the agreement between the buyer and the merchant at agreed upon prices, terms, and delivery dates. Purchase orders are required when purchasing goods and/or services. Purchase orders must be completed PRIOR TO goods and/or services being purchased.
- b. **Purchase Requisition.** The purchase requisition is the method in which the department requests a purchase order for goods and/or services to be purchased. The purchase requisition informs the purchasing department of the goods and/or services needed by the department, and which budgetary line item should be charged for the purchase. A purchase requisition shall be completed by the department head, elected official, or their designee. Purchase requisitions not completely filled out will result in a delay in processing the purchase order.
- c. Check Request. The check request is submitted for goods or services that have been classified by the purchasing guidelines as not requiring a purchase order (see list below). Completed check request forms and corresponding

invoices are submitted to the Accounts Payable Manager for processing and payment. The following items are eligible to be submitted on a check request:

- i. Auditing Services
- ii. Banking Fees
- iii. Bid Advertisements
- iv. Newspaper Subscriptions
- v. Periodical Subscriptions
- vi. Bonds
- vii. Boards and Committee Member Payments
- viii. Contributions to Component Units
- ix. Dues
- x. Freight/Shipping
- xi. Inter-Departmental Billing
- xii. Jury Fees
- xiii. Legal Fees
- xiv. Cell Phone Charges
- xv. Payroll Reimbursements
- xvi. Reimbursements (i.e., travel, in-service, etc.)
- xvii. Tuition
- xviii. Utilities
  - 1. Telephone
  - 2. Natural Gas
  - 3. Electricity
  - xix. Vehicle Tags
  - xx. Workman's Compensation Payments

### V. Purchases with Grant Funds

County personnel must exercise care to comply with applicable requirements or special terms of any grant agreements or donations. All applicable local, state, and federal regulations must be followed. Purchases made with local, state, and federal grant funds shall be conducted in a manner consistent with grant contracts and in a fashion to provide maximum open, free, and fair competition.

County personnel must exercise in a fashion to provide maximum open, free and fair competition.

To achieve the objective stated above, purchases made with federal grant funds will be made following an open bid process that involves the issuance of a public notice on the county website and publication in a newspaper of regional circulation. The bid proposals will be opened publicly and then analyzed to ensure they meet all the bid requirements and specifications. Based on the bid analysis, the County's purchasing manager will recommend to the county legislative body the vendor and price for the purchase of the item or service sought through the bid process. The county legislative body must approve the lowest and/or best bid before a purchase order can be issued for the item/service.

Documentation of the bid process, the proposals received, bid approval, purchase order and delivery receipt will be maintained for five (5) years in the grant file maintained by the county's grant manager.

### VI. Vendors

- a. Federal, State, and Local Law Compliance. Vendors must comply with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations, including but not limited to Title VI of the Federal Civil Rights Act of 1964, prohibiting discrimination in employment practices or in the performance of the resulting contract, on the grounds of race, age, color, religion, sex, national origin, handicap and/or disability, or any other classification protected by federal, state, or local law.
- b. Equal Opportunity. Equal opportunity shall be given to all eligible vendors. Each order will be placed on the basis of quality, price, delivery, and service history. Hamblen County Government considers all eligible vendors without regard to race color, religion, creed, gender, national origin, age, disability, marital or veteran status, or any other legally protected status. Invitations to Bid are open to any vendor, published online, and in local newspapers to encourage all applicable vendors to participate, including Certified Disadvantaged Business Enterprises and other small, minority, and women-owned businesses. Contractors doing business with Hamblen County Government shall indicate their compliance with Title VI of the Federal Civil Rights Act of 1964.
- c. Purchases from Minority or Women-Owned Businesses, Small Business Enterprises, and Any Protected Class Vendor. Hamblen County Government extends purchasing opportunities to all minority, women-owned business, small business enterprises, and any protected class vendor through the public competitive bid process, which includes public notice of all sealed bid opportunities. All protected class vendors are encouraged to do business with Hamblen County Government.
- d. IRS Form W-9. To comply with Internal Revenue Service requirements, all vendors who perform any type of service for Hamblen County Government are required to have a current IRS Form W-9 on file with the Hamblen County Finance Department.
- e. **Tennessee Lawful Employment Act.** To comply with the Tennessee Lawful Employment Act, non-employees (individuals hired as independent contractors) must have on file any <u>one</u> of the following documents:
  - i. Valid Tennessee driver's license or photo identification
  - ii. Valid out-of-state driver's license
  - iii. U.S. birth certificate
  - iv. Valid U.S. passport
  - v. U.S. certificate of birth abroad of a U.S. citizen
  - vi. Certificate of citizenship

- vii. Certificate of naturalization
- viii. U.S. citizen identification card
- ix. Valid alien registration documentation or proof of current immigration registration.
