CERTIFICATE OF AWARD

The undersigned County Executive of Hamblen County, Tennessee (the County), having been authorized by resolutions adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on August 16, 1993, and September 13, 1993, to sell the County's \$8,000,000 Hospital Revenue and Tax Bonds, Series 1993, and \$2,300,000 General Obligation Bonds, Series 1993 (the Bonds), and to take certain actions in connection with the issuance and sale of the Bonds, hereby states as follows:

1. The Bonds were duly advertised and the following bids were received by 11:00 o'clock a.m., E.D.T., on October 26, 1993, at the Hamblen County Courthouse in Morristown, Tennessee:

(a) Bid of Morgan Keegan & Company offering to pay \$10,197,100 for the Bonds bearing interest at the rates set forth in Column 1 on Exhibit A attached hereto.

(b) Bid of Trust Company Bank offering to pay \$10,197,000 for the Bonds bearing interest at the rates set forth in Column 2 on Exhibit A attached hereto.

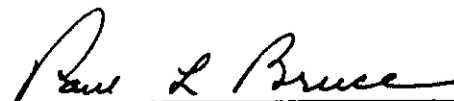
Each of the bids provided for payment of accrued interest on the Bonds from the date of the Bonds to the date of delivery.
