This letter acknowledges receipt of a certified copy of the fiscal year 2019 budget.


We have reviewed the budget and have determined that projected revenues and other funds are sufficient to meet anticipated expenditures. Our review of the budget is based the information we have received and is for determining that the budget appears to be balanced. With regard to programs included in the budget such as education, roads, and corrections, we have not attempted to determine that the local government has complied with specific program statutes or guidelines, or with any financing requirements prescribed by any state or federal agency. A property tax rate may be included in this budget, and we would recommend that local government officials be certain that all program requirements have been met before initiating the tax collection process.

This letter constitutes approval, by this office, for the County's fiscal year 2019 budget as adopted by the County Commission.

Considerations Concerning the Budget

The Office of State and Local Finance has determined that the County's budget meets basic statutory requirements, but we have detected a challenge, outlined below, that could possibly lead to financial problems in the future.

As part of the annual budget submission process required by T.C.A. § 9-21-403, the County provided a projected monthly cash flow analysis for the General Purpose School Fund, (the "Fund"). A review of the analysis indicated that the Fund is budgeted to have an amount of cash at the end of fiscal year 2019 equal to less than one-month's average monthly spending. The Fund appears to have sufficient cash during fiscal year 2019 to remain balanced; however, to ensure this continues, the County's finance staff should provide the following information to the Commission, if it does not already do so:

- An updated cash flow analysis for the Fund showing actual data from the prior month and any changes to forecasted data, and
- A budget-to-actual report for the Fund including both revenue collections and expenditures.

Please submit these reports to the Commission at each regular meeting. As part of a financially well-run county, we recommend that the County's finance staff provide the Commission these reports for all funds.

HEC submits the application fee of \$2,000 with this application on the basis of a service area population of 119,377, as reflected by the most recent decennial census.

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2. <u>Description of Municipalities and Unincorporated Areas to be Served in Whole or in</u>
Part.

HEC seeks a state-issues certificate of franchise authority to provide video services within its electric service territory in the incorporated and unincorporated portions of Hawkins and Hamblen Counties in East Tennessee. HEC's territory includes Rogersville, Russellville and Church Hill. A map of HEC's service territory is attached to this Application as Exhibit A.

3. Intent to Serve.

HEC intends to begin offering video and internet services in each of the municipalities and the unincorporated areas of each county described in subdivision (c)(2) within twenty-four (24) months of the date of the issuance of a state-issued certificate of franchise authority.

4. Indemnity.

In accordance with § 7-59-318, HEC agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the state, municipality, county and any employee or representative of the state, municipality or county, as well as any political subdivision of the state and any employee or representative of the political subdivision, individually and collectively from all claims, demands, causes of action, liability, judgments, costs and expenses or losses for injury or death to persons or damage to property owned by, and workers' compensation claims, collectively referred to in this section as claims, against any parties indemnified in accordance with this section, arising out of, caused by, or as a result of the holder's exercising its authority granted under a state-issued certificate of franchise authority,

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except for claims related to public, educational or governmental channels controlled by an indemnitee or other third-party designated by the indemnitee.

HEC has the managerial, financial, and technical qualifications to provide video service as required by Tenn. Code Ann. 7-59-305(c)(6) and (d)(2).

It is the policy of HEC to resolve customer complaints and to answer questions promptly with a focus on customer satisfaction. HEC has a written Customer Service Policy, which includes a dispute resolution procedure. In the event of a customer dispute, HEC conducts an investigation, attempts to resolve any dispute informally in a manner that is

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mutually satisfactory to both parties, allows examination of any relevant records of the Cooperative, and provides for a hearing in front of an individual appointed or designated by the General Manager. In the event of a hearing, the customer has the right to be represented, and the hearing officer will render any decision in writing, with a copy to the customer.



MINORITY-OWNED BUSINESS PARTICIPATION PLAN

The following is Holston Electric Cooperative's plan to actively solicit bids from minority and women owned businesses (MWOBs) and to award contracts to such qualified businesses when feasible as HEC begins to establish and provide video services Tennessee. HEC is adopting this plan consistent with the requirements of the Tennessee legislature and its intent to promote, increase, and improve the quality and participation of MWOBs in the procurement and supply chains for Tennessee businesses.

- (c) past practices of racial discrimination against African-Americans.

HEC shall endeavor to promote, increase and improve the quality of the overall participation of MWOBs when HEC purchases materials and services. HEC shall afford every opportunity for MWOBs to participate as suppliers of materials and services to HEC. HEC shall also encourage subcontracting opportunities for MWOBs by requiring its prime contractors to provide information on their own diversity participation plans and considering such information when selecting contractors.

Pursuant to this plan, HEC shall strive to maximize the participation of MWOBs through both prime and second tier business opportunities and shall strive to achieve a level of participation representative of the population demographics within the state of Tennessee.

On or before January 31 of each year, HEC will prepare an annual report to the Tennessee Public Utilities Commission about its compliance with this Plan.

WHEREAS, the Hamblen County Commission supports all attempts to improve recycling opportunities within Hamblen County; and

WHEREAS, the System is committed to providing necessary matching funds and/or in-kind services which will be used to satisfy the forty percent (40%) funding match required by the TDEC recycling and convenience center grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Hamblen County Commission hereby authorizes the County Mayor or his representative(s) to prepare grant applications to fund the proposed improvements at the Hamblen County – Morristown landfill. The applications would seek grant funds not to exceed \$200,000 with 40% of the total project cost to be matched by Hamblen County through the System, the City of Morristown and other in-kind matching sources. If awarded the grant funding, Hamblen County in partnership with the System will meet the time deadlines outlined in the grant contract.

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COMMERCIAL LEASE FOR COUNTY CLERK SATELLITE OFFICE

THIS COMMERCIAL LEASE is hereby made and entered into this 24th day of August, 2018 by and between Mark L. Sawyer ("Landlord") and Hamblen County, a political subdivision of the State of Tennessee ("Tenant").

WITNESSETH:

For and in consideration of the rental, undertakings and mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, Landlord hereby leases to Tenant, and Tenant hereby leases from Landlord, subject to the terms and conditions hereafter expressed, certain office space more particularly described and located within the Landlord's real estate described as:

Street Address: 2415 N Davy Crockett Parkway, Morristown, Tennessee, 37814

The "Leased Premises" shall be three thousand three hundred sixty (3,360) square feet interior office suites located in the building formerly housing Epes Transport Systems. Further included in the leased premises is the use of the parking area surrounding the landlord's building.

The covenants and conditions of this Lease are as follows:

- 1. Term: This Lease shall commence on June 1, 2018 and end on June 30, 2019 (the "Initial Term"). Tenant shall have the option to renew the Lease for an additional one (1) year term (the "Renewal Term") by providing Landlord with written notice of its desire to exercise this option as least thirty (30) days prior to the end of the Initial Term.
 - Landlord shall have the right within the last sixty (60) days of the Initial Term or within the last thirty (30) days of the Renewal Term to show the Leased Premises to prospective tenants.
- 2. Rent: The rent amount will be \$1,850 per month beginning with the first day of June 2018 for a total of thirteen (13) months.
 - The Tenant agrees to pay to the Landlord during the Initial Term an amount equal to the 2018 Hamblen County and City of Morristown property taxes for the office space and one-half acre of land based on the assessed value on file in the Hamblen County Assessor of Property's office. The tenant agrees to pay ½ of the Hamblen County and City of Morristown 2019 property taxes if the lease is not renewed beyond the Initial Term. The Tenant is exempt from personal property taxes.
- 3. Alterations and Improvements: All additions and improvements made in and upon the Leased Premises, either by Tenant or Landlord, shall be the Landlord's sole property or shall remain upon the Leased Premises at the termination of this Lease, without compensation to the Tenant.



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4. Maintenance and Repair: Tenant agrees to maintain the Leased Premises in the same general condition as when received, ordinary wear and tear and damage by the elements excepted. Tenant also agrees to keep the Leased Premises free from trash, garbage and other waste.

Tenant agrees to pay Landlord, upon demand, for any and all loss or damage to the Leased Premises caused by Tenant's misuse, waste, or neglect or caused by any of Tenant's employees, agents, clients, visitors or anyone else invited by or under the control of Tenant again, normal wear and tear excepted.

Tenant shall not allow any unlawful activities to take place upon the Leased Premises.

Tenant shall promptly notify Landlord of any accident to or defect in the water pipes, sewer pipes, gas pipes, electric wiring, heating or air conditioning systems or fixtures. It is agreed that Landlord shall not in any case be liable in damages for any temporary breakdown of said facilities or discontinuance of services provided by such facilities. Tenant agrees to take all reasonable steps to protect the plumbing during freezing weather.

Plumbing repairs and ordinary maintenance shall be the responsibility of the Tenant. Repairs will include the cost of backup of services and drains from fixtures within the Leased Premises. The cost of such service and repair from "backup" will be the sole expense of the Tenant.

Tenant is responsible for all HVAC issues, maintenance of all fixtures and components and replacement of any such fixtures and components as long as the contract is active.

Tenant shall be responsible for all janitorial service, supplies and associated appliances to be used in connection with janitorial services, including paper towel dispensers, paper goods, etc.

Any sign attached to the outside of the building is the responsibility of the Tenant. Such sign must be approved by appropriate municipal authorities and the Landlord. The Landlord agrees to allow Tenant to replace the Parkway Auto Sales sign at the highway so long as the Parkway Auto Sales sign is reinstalled in proper working condition before the Tenant vacates the Leased Premises.

- 5. Utilities and Other Charges: Tenant shall be responsible for arranging for and paying for all electricity, water, telephone, alarm system, gas, internet, and other utility charges for the Leased Premises and the deposits for same.
- 6. Right of Inspection: Landlord shall have the right to enter the Leased Premises at all reasonable hours during the day to inspect the same or to make such repairs and alterations as may be necessary for the safety and preservation of the Leased Premises. Landlord shall make every reasonable effort to notify Tenant of inspections.
- 7. Insurance Provisions: Landlord shall maintain property and casualty insurance on said property. Tenant shall not use or permit upon the Leased Premises anything that will invalidate any insurance policy now or hereafter in effect on the Leased Premises or that will increase the rate of insurance or cause such insurance to be canceled.

Tenant's	Initials:	BB
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Tenant shall provide his own insurance covering personal property and premises liability with minimum liability limits of \$1,000,000 and shall name Mark L. Sawyer as Additional Insured. A copy of said policy, or acceptable Certificate of Insurance shall be given to Landlord within five (5) business days of inhabiting the premises.

- 8. Landlord Duties: Landlord shall be responsible for all repairs to the structure and roof of the building. Landlord will maintain and clean the exterior of the Building, the grounds and the parking lot. Landlord will support Tenant placing approved signage on the outside of the building if the Tenant chooses.
- 9. Abandonment. If any time during the term of this lease, Tenant abandons the Leased Premises, Landlord may, at his option, enter the Leased Premises by any means without being liable for any prosecution therefore, and without becoming liable to Tenant for damages of any kind whatsoever.
- 10. Damage or Destruction. If, during the Initial Term of this Lease or the Renewal Term, the demised premises shall be or become damaged by fire or by elements, such damage shall be promptly repaired by the Landlord, unless the damage to said premises hereby leased or devised be so great that the same cannot be repaired with reasonable diligence so as to be fit for occupancy. In such event, the rent herein provided to be paid for the said Lease Premises shall abate and be suspended for a period of time from the date of the damage to the Leased Premises hereby leased until the date when the said premises are so repaired as to be ready for occupancy by the Tenant. In such event the tenancy of the Leased Premises hereby leased or demised shall not be terminated, but shall remain in force and effect under and by virtue of the terms and conditions of this Lease, unless the damage done to the Leased Premises hereby leased shall be so great as to make it impossible to repair the premises which the period of ninety (90) days, in which case the Tenant shall have the option of vacating the premises hereby leased or demised and of bringing to an end and terminating this Lease; provided, however, that the said Tenant shall not have such option and shall not be allowed to be relieved from the obligation of this Lease if the damage done to the premises shall in any wise be caused by the intentional act of any agent or representative of the Tenant while acting on behalf of the Tenant.
- 11. If Tenant shall fail to perform or comply with any of the other conditions, terms or agreements in this Lease as set forth herein within thirty (30) days after notice written by Landlord to Tenant specifying the condition to be performed or complied with.

In the event of any default hereunder, Landlord, at any time thereafter, may terminate the Lease at its option and/or re-enter the Leased Premises and expel, remove and put out Tenant or any person or persons occupying the Leased Premises and remove all personal property there from as allowed by law.

Upon re-entry Landlord may, at its option, release the Leased Premises or any party thereof as the agent of tenant and Tenant shall pay Landlord the difference between the rent herein reserved and imposed for the portion of the term remaining at the time of re-entry and the amount received under such releasing for such portion of the term; additionally, Landlord may



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also recover from Tenant any other sums (including rents) then due. Landlord may also terminate these Leases and recover from Tenant any sums then due.

Notwithstanding any other provision herein contained, Tenant shall be responsible for all losses (including loss of rents) and damages resulting from any default and/or termination of this Lease. If this Lease is placed in the hands of an attorney, after default or breach, for the enforcement of any rights of Landlord herein, Tenant, agrees to pay all costs of such enforcement or collection, including reasonable attorney's fees.

- 12. Surrender of Premises. At the termination of this Lease, Tenant shall return and surrender the Leased Premises hereby demised without demand of the Landlord in the same condition and properly cleaned, as they were at the time of execution of this Lease, normal wear and tear expected.
- 13. Assignment and Subletting. Landlord agrees to the Tenant subletting 1,860 square feet of office space to the State of Tennessee for use by Administrators of the Courts (AOC). The term of the lease between the Tenant and the State of Tennessee will not extend beyond the term between the Tenant and the Landlord.



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JAG Solicitation Hamblen County Program Narrative

Description of the Issues

Currently, HCSD must rely on other agencies to examine cell phones and computers for evidence of illegal activity. This dependency on other agencies prolongs investigations and can endanger victims. This dependency also adds to the already burdensome workload of the agencies assisting us. Since the caseload for all our supporting agencies has increased, our wait time on the forensic analysis we need has increased from one to two days to more than one week. This can be the difference between life and death in some situations.

The Hamblen County Sheriff's Department (HCSD) plans to procure and then implement a mobile forensics program to assist with investigations to culminate in either prosecutions or dismissal of investigations of alleged criminal activity.

Once funds are obtained for this program and the platform to support it, it can be procured and operational with six months. We plan to either secure a 24 months license for this program.

Project Design and Implementation and Capabilities and Competencies

The Hamblen County Sheriff's Department (HCSD) plans to procure and then implement a mobile forensics program to assist with investigations to culminate in either prosecutions or dismissal of investigations of alleged criminal activity.

The HCSD has the support of two regional police departments and the regional office of the FBI in its current investigations requiring digital forensic analysis. These departments support the HCSD in developing independent capability and in being able to aid them in any joint investigations they may undertake.

Once funds are obtained for this program and platform to support it, it can be procured and operational with six months. We plan to either secure a 24 months license for this program.

Areas of Emphasis

HCSD will use this mobile forensics tool to collect evidence and aid in sound investigative practice to support the collaborative efforts of our prosecution and law enforcement partners. We want to stress the importance of this one tool in assisting with investigations of the most violent crimes we encounter such as child sex crimes, narcotic investigations, and homicides to name some the most recent examples of crimes where we could have used this program.





- 1. American Institute of Architects (AIA) 101-2017 shall be the contract agreement between Sons of the Revolution (S.O.T.R.) and the Contractor.
- AIA 201-2017, General Conditions of the Construction Contract shall be the contract agreement's General Conditions between S.O.T.R. and the Contractor.
- 3. AIA 312, Performance and Payment Bonds shall be the contract agreement's Bonding Conditions between S.O.T.R. and the Contractor. An irrevocable letter of credit may be proposed by the bidder as an alternate to these bonds.
- 4. Within the contract, the Contractor shall agree to proposed linkages with the Architect through the Construction Administration stage. The Contractor shall provide all engineering data and shop drawings as required for necessary systems to the Architect. Contractor shall pay all fees associated with these documents.
- The Contractor shall be responsible for bringing the project in for a guaranteed maximum price. Said price shall be the Stipulated Sum per AIA 101.
- 6. The Contractor shall be responsible for payment of Construction fees and permits.
- 7. The Contractor shall state unit prices for work associated with site utilities and site building excavation/preparation.
- 8. The Contractor shall utilize the purchases of local goods or services.
- 9. The Contractor shall receive a 25% (twenty five percent) incentive for each dollar of construction cost savings upon establishment of the projects' Stipulated Sum cost.
- 10. The Contractor accepts the condition for Liquidated Damages in the amount of \$400.00 (four hundred dollars) per day.
- The Contractor shall achieve Substantial Completion of the Work within 75 (Seventy Five) calendar days from the date stipulated in the Notice to Proceed. Said notice shall be issued upon receipt of the City's issue of a construction permit.
