RESOLUTION 20-26

**RESOLUTION TO LEVY A TAX RATE IN EXCESS OF THE CERTIFIED TAX RATE
FOR THE COUNTY OF HAMBLLEN, TENNESSEE**

WHEREAS, *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 67-5-1701(a), requires that, in the event of a general reappraisal in a county, the county legislative body shall determine and certify a tax rate which will provide the same ad valorem revenue for that jurisdiction as was levied during the previous year; and

WHEREAS, *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 67-5-1701(b), authorizes the State Board of Equalization to establish policies providing a procedure or formula for calculating the certified tax rate and Hamblen County followed that procedure after reappraisal in 2020; and,

WHEREAS, *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 67-5-1702, authorizes a county legislative body to exceed the certified tax rate set according to *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 67-5-1701, by resolution after advertising its intent to exceed the certified tax rate in a newspaper of general circulation in the county (with an affidavit of publication sent within thirty days after publication to the State Board of Equalization) and public hearing; and

WHEREAS, Hamblen County desires to levy a tax rate in excess of the certified tax rate;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Hamblen County, Tennessee, meeting regular session on the 23rd day of July, 2020, that the combined property tax rate for Hamblen County, Tennessee for the year beginning July 1, 2020, shall be \$1.76 on each \$100 of taxable property inside the corporate limits of the City of Morristown and \$1.97 on each \$100 of taxable property outside the corporate limits of the City of Morristown, which is to provide revenue for each of the following funds and otherwise conform to the following tax levies:

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there is hereby levied a gross receipts business tax as provided by law. The proceeds of the gross receipts tax herein levied shall accrue to the General Fund.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there is levied a motor vehicle privilege tax as provided by law. The proceeds of the \$27 motor vehicle privilege tax herein levied shall accrue \$27 to the General Fund.

SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there is levied a hotel/motel occupancy tax as provided by law. The proceeds of the hotel/motel occupancy tax herein levied shall accrue to the General Fund for the specific purpose of capital improvements to Cherokee Park.

SECTION 6. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a local option sales tax is levied as provided by law. The first 50% of the sales tax shall accrue to the General Purpose School Fund; of the remaining 50%, the first \$86,000 shall accrue to the Highway/Public Works Fund, the next \$63,000 shall accrue to the General Debt Service Fund, and the remainder shall accrue to the Solid Waste/Sanitation Fund.

SECTION 7. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that revenues derived from State Revenue Sharing - T.V.A. shall accrue as follows: the first \$200,000 shall accrue to the Highway/Public Works Fund, and the ~~January 2022~~ revenues shall accrue to the General Fund.

SECTION 8. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that revenues derived from interest earned on the cash balances in the Central Cafeteria Fund shall accrue to that fund; revenues derived from interest earned on the cash balances in the Drug Control Fund shall accrue to that fund; all other interest earnings from operating funds shall accrue to the General Debt Service Fund.

SECTION 9. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that revenues derived from \$0.02 (two cents) of the property tax levied to the General Debt Service Fund shall accrue and be restricted for the purpose of retiring debt issued for construction and renovation, related to Morrystown-Hamblen High School West.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the budget for the School Federal Projects Fund shall be the budget approved for separate projects within the fund by the Tennessee Department of Education and the Hamblen County Board of Education.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there are also hereby appropriated certain portions of the commissions and fees for collecting taxes and licenses and for administering other funds which the Trustee, County Clerk, Circuit Court Clerk, Clerk and Master, Register, and the Sheriff and their officially authorized deputies and assistants may be entitled to receive under State laws heretofore or hereafter enacted. Expenditures out of commissions, and/or fees collected by the Trustee, County Clerk, Circuit Court Clerk, Clerk and Master, Register and the Sheriff may be made for such purposes and in such amounts as may be authorized by existing law or by valid order of any court having power to make such appropriations. Any excess commissions and/or fees collected over and above the expenditures duly and conclusively authorized shall be paid over to the Trustee and converted into the General Fund as provided by law.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any fee officials, as enumerated in Section 8-22-101, *Tennessee Code Annotated*, operate under provisions of Section 8-22-104, *Tennessee Code Annotated*, provisions of the preceding paragraph shall not apply to those particular officials.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any amendment to the budget, except for amendments to the budget for funds under supervision of the Director of Schools, shall be approved as provided in Section 5-9-407, *Tennessee Code Annotated*. The Director of Schools must receive approval of the Board of Education for transfers within each major category of the budget, and approval of both the Board of Education and the Board of County Commissioners for transfers between major categories as required by law.

One copy of each amendment shall be filed with the County Clerk, one copy with the Chairman of the Finance Committee, and one with each divisional or departmental head concerned. The reason(s) for each transfer shall be clearly stated; however, this provision shall in no case whatsoever be construed as authorizing transfer from one fund to another, but shall apply solely to transfers within a certain fund.

SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any appropriations made by this resolution, which cover the same purpose for which a specific appropriation is made by statute is made in lieu of but not in addition to said statutory appropriation. The salary, wages, or remuneration of each officer, employee, or agent of the County shall not be in excess of the amounts authorized by existing law or as set forth in the estimate of expenditures which accompanies this resolution. Provided, however, that appropriations for such salaries, wages, or other remuneration hereby authorized shall in no case be construed as permitting expenditures for an office, agency, institution, division or department of the County in excess of the appropriation made herein for such office, agency, institution, division or department of the County. Such appropriation shall constitute the limit to the expenditures of any office, agency, institution, division or department for the year ending June 30, 2021. The aggregate expenditures for any item of appropriation shall in no instance be more than the amount herein appropriated for such item.

SECTION 6. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resolution which may hereafter be presented to the Board of County Commissioners providing for appropriations in addition to those made by this Budget Appropriations Resolution shall specifically provide sufficient revenue or other funds actually to be provided during the fiscal year in which the expenditure is to be made to meet such additional appropriation. Said appropriating resolution shall be submitted to and approved by the State Director of Local Finance after its adoption as provided by Section 9-21-403, *Tennessee Code Annotated*.

SECTION 7. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Mayor and County Clerk are hereby authorized to borrow money on revenue anticipation notes, provided such notes are first approved by the State Director of Local Government Finance, to pay for the expenses herein authorized until the taxes and other revenue for the year 2020-2021 have been collected. The proceeds of loans for each individual fund shall not exceed 60% of the appropriations of each individual fund and shall be used only to pay the expenses and other requirements of the fund for which the loan is made. The loan shall be paid out of revenue from the fund for which money is borrowed. The notes evidencing the loans authorized under this section shall be issued under the applicable sections of Title 9, Chapter 21, and *Tennessee Code Annotated*. Said notes shall be signed by the County Mayor and countersigned by the County Clerk and shall mature and be paid in full without renewal no later than June 30, 2021.

SECTION 8. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the delinquent County property taxes for the year 2019 and prior years and the interest and penalty thereon collected during the year ending June 30, 2021, shall be appropriated to the various County funds according to the subdivision of the tax levy for the year 2019. The Clerk and Master and the Trustee are hereby authorized and directed to make such apportionment accordingly.

SECTION 9. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all unencumbered balances of appropriations remaining at the end of the fiscal year shall lapse, and be of no further effect at the end of the year at June 30, 2021.



NOT TO EXCEED \$300,000

WHEREAS, the County Commission of Hamblen County, Tennessee (the Local Government) has determined that it is necessary and desirable to provide funds for the following public works project: **Payment of Costs for Various Safety Projects including striping, lighting and other traffic safety projects around Hamblen County Schools** (the "Project") at a cost of **\$300,000** and an economic life of **15** years; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission has determined that the Project will promote or provide a traditional governmental activity or otherwise fulfill a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Parts I, IV, and VI of Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated, local governments in Tennessee are authorized to finance the cost of the Project through the issuance and sale of interest bearing capital outlay notes with a maturity of up to three years upon the approval of the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of §9-21-408 of Title 9 Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated, Local Governments in Tennessee are authorized to make interfund loans in accordance with procedures for issuance of notes in § 9-21-604 of Title 9 Chapter 21 Tennessee Code Annotated.

WHEREAS, the County Commission finds that it is advantageous to the Local Government to authorize the issuance of capital outlay notes to finance the cost of the Project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Commission of **Hamblen County**, Tennessee, as follows:

Section 1. That, for the purpose of providing funds to finance the cost of the Project in and for the Local Government, the **Hamblen County Mayor** of the Local Government is hereby authorized in accordance with the terms of this resolution, and upon approval of the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee, to issue and sell interest-bearing capital outlay notes in a principal amount not to exceed **Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000)** (the "Notes") from the **General Debt Service Fund** to the **General Capital Projects Fund** upon approval of the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee pursuant to the terms, provisions, and conditions permitted by law. The Notes shall be designated "**Hamblen County Interfund Loan Capital Outlay Notes, Series 2020**", shall be numbered serially from 1a upwards; shall be dated as of the date of issuance; shall be in denomination (s) as agreed upon by the legislative governing body; shall be sold at not less than 99% of par value and accrued interest; and shall bear interest at a rate or rates not to exceed **zero percent (0%)** per annum, and in no event shall the rate exceed the legal limit provided by law.

Section 2. That, the Notes shall mature not later than **three (3)** years after the date of issuance and that the Notes and any extension or renewal notes shall not exceed the reasonably expected economic life of the Project, which is hereby certified by the County Commission to be at least **15** years. Provided, however, that each year the Notes are outstanding, **one-third (1/3)** of the

original principal amount of the Notes shall mature without renewal but subject to prior redemption.

Section 3. That, the Notes shall be subject to redemption at the option of the Local Government, in whole or in part, at any time, at the principal amount and accrued interest to the date of redemption, without a premium, or, if sold at par, with or without a premium of not exceeding one percent (1%) of the principal amount.

Section 4. That, the Notes shall be direct general obligations of the Local Government, for which the punctual payment of the principal and interest on the notes, the full faith and credit of the Local Government is irrevocably pledged and the Local Government hereby pledges its taxing power as to all taxable property in the Local Government for the purpose of providing funds for the payment of principal of and interest on the Notes. The County Commission of the Local Government hereby authorizes the levy and collection of a special tax on all taxable property of the Local government over and above all other taxes authorized by the Local government to create a sinking fund to retire the Notes with interest as they mature in an amount necessary for that purpose.

Section 5. That, the Notes shall be executed in the name of the Local Government and bear the manual signature of the **Hamblen County Mayor** and the manual signature of the **Hamblen County Clerk** with the Local Government seal affixed thereon; and shall be payable as to principal and interest at the office of the **County Trustee** of the Local Government or the paying agent duly appointed by the Local Government. Proceeds of the Notes shall be deposited with the **County Trustee** of the Local Government and shall be paid out for the purpose of financing the Project pursuant to this Resolution and as required by law.

Section 6. That, the Notes will be issued in fully registered form and that at all times during which any Notes remains outstanding and unpaid, the Local Government or its agent shall keep or cause to be kept at its office a note register, if held by an agent of the Local Government, shall at all times be open for inspection by the Local Government or any duly authorized officer of the Local Government. Each Note shall have the qualities and incidents of a negotiable instrument and shall be transferable only upon the note register kept by the Local Government or its agent, by the registered owner of the Note in person or by the registered owner's attorney duly authorized in writing, upon presentation and surrender to the Local Government or its agent together with a written instrument of transfer satisfactory to the Local Government duly executed by the registered owner of the registered owner's duly authorized attorney. Upon the transfer of any such Note, the Local Government shall issue in the name of the transferee a new registered note or notes of the same aggregate principal amount and maturity as the surrendered Notes. The Local Government shall not be obligated to make any such Note transfer during the fifteen (15) days next preceding an interest payment date of the Notes or, in the case of any redemption of the Notes, during the forty-five (45) days next preceding the date of redemption.

Section 7. That, the Notes shall be in substantially the form authorized by the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee and shall recite that the Notes are issued pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated.

Section 8. The Notes shall not be sold until receipt of the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee's written approval for the sale of the Notes.


Section 9. That the Notes may be designated as qualified tax-exempt obligations for the purpose of Section 265(b) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

Section 10. That, after the sale of the Notes, and for each year that any of the notes are outstanding, the Local Government shall prepare an annual budget in a form consistent with accepted

governmental standards and as approved by the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee (the "Director".) The budget shall be kept balanced during the life of the notes. The annual budget shall be submitted to the Director immediately upon its adoption; however, it shall not become the official budget for the fiscal year until such budget is approved by the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee in accordance with Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated (the "Statutes".) If the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee determines that the budget does not comply with the Statutes, the County Commission shall adjust its estimates or make additional tax levies sufficient to comply with the Statutes, or as directed by the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee.



Both principal of and interest on this note are payable at the office of the **Hamblen County Trustee** of the Local Government or a paying agent duly appointed by the Local Government in lawful money of the United States of America.

This note is a direct obligation of the Local Government for the payment of which as to both principal and interest the full faith and credit of the Local Government is pledged.

This note is subject to redemption prior to its stated maturity in whole or in part at any time at the option of the Local Government upon payment of the principal amount of the note together with the interest accrued thereon to the date of redemption with a premium of **0%** of par value.

This note is issued under the authority of Parts I, IV, and VI of Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated, and a Resolution duly adopted by the County Commission of the Local Government meeting in session on the **23rd day of July, 2020** (the "Resolution") to provide funds to finance the cost of public works projects referenced in the Resolution.

JULY 23, 2020

This note shall have the qualities and incidents of a negotiable instrument and shall be transferable only upon the note register kept by the Local Government or its agent, by the Registered Owner of the note in person or by the Registered Owner's attorney duly authorized in writing, upon presentation and surrender to the Local Government or its agent of the note together with a written instrument of transfer satisfactory to the Local Government duly executed by the Registered Owner or the Registered Owner's duly authorized attorney but only in the manner as provided in the Resolution of the Local Government authorizing the issuance of this note and upon surrender hereof for cancellation. Upon the transfer of any such note, the Local Government or its agent shall issue in the name of the transferee a new registered note or notes of the same aggregate principal amount and maturity as the surrendered note. The Local Government shall not be obligated to make any such Note transfer during the fifteen (15) days next preceding an interest payment date on the Notes or, in the case of any redemption of the Notes, during the forty-five (45) days next preceding the date of redemption.

Title 9, Chapter 21, Section 117, Tennessee Code Annotated provides that this note and interest thereon are exempt from taxation by the State of Tennessee or by any county, municipality or taxing district of the State, except for inheritance, transfer and estate taxes and except as otherwise provided under the laws of the State of Tennessee.

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED, RECITED AND DECLARED that all acts, conditions and things required to exist, happen and be performed precedent to and in the issuance of this note exist, have happened and have been performed in due time, form and manner as required by the Constitution and laws of the State of Tennessee, and that the amount of this note, together with all other indebtedness of the Hamblen County, does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitation thereon, and that this note is within every constitutional and statutory limitation.



Property Swap Proposal w/M-H Rescue Squad July 2020

Property Swap –

- I.) Hamblen County deed the Whitehead property at 425 N. Jackson Street to the Rescue Squad in exchange for:
 - i) The eastern half of the vacant lot north of the main Rescue Squad building (Map 33L-D-25.00) where the training tower stands
 - ii) The EMS office building located at 419 Allison Street (Map 33I-D-30.00)
 - iii) The EMS vacant lot located at 413 Allison Street (Map 33L-D-29.00)
- II.) Hamblen County pay the Rescue Squad \$75,000 for moving expenses and building repairs
Rescue Squad will provide estimates of anticipated expenses and repairs.
- III.) Hamblen County allows the Rescue Squad to move the HVAC unit from its Allison Street property to its new office location at 425 N. Jackson Street

Main Rescue Squad Building Property –

- I.) The County agrees to lease to the Rescue Squad the property with the building for 99 years at \$1/per year, tax exempt and the Rescue Squad agrees to pay the upkeep, maintenance and liability insurance for the building and property. The Rescue Squad must obtain permission from Hamblen County to expand the building during the term of the lease. The lease will be recorded in the Register of Deeds office.
- II.) At the expiration of the lease, the Rescue Squad has an option to renew the lease for a term to be determined at that time;
- III.) If the Rescue Squad decides not to renew the lease, the property and building revert to Hamblen County for the appraised value of the building only. The appraisal will be conducted by a certified commercial appraiser that both parties agree and the cost of the appraisal will be shared equally by the two parties.
- IV.) The lease agreement will have an out clause for both parties that includes ample time for either party to react to the termination request of the other.
