





I have served as the Hamblen County Coroner since May, 1991. We have just completed the busiest month in my almost thirty years of service. For the past several years we have averaged approximately 50 to 55 Calls\*1 per month. For January, 2021 my Deputies and I responded to 103 Calls. I am proud that we were able to serve our community by taking care of all these families.

The difference that made January so busy was COVID 19! 51 of the deaths were caused by COVID 19. Of the 51, 37 were residents of Hamblen County with various ages and many with pre-existing conditions. The other 14 deaths were folks from surrounding counties who came to our county for medical care.

From my observations, our community was prepared and rose to meet the needs! Under to leadership of our Medical Examiner our EMS, Hospital, Doctors, Nurses, Law Enforcement, Fire Departments, Dispatchers and Funeral Homes all worked together to meet the needs.

\*1 As a reminder, based upon T.C.A. 38-708, "The Medical Examiner and Coroner ust be notified immediately by: "Any person having knowledge of the death of any person from sudden violence or by casualty or by suicide or suddenly when in apparent health or when found dead or in prison or in any suspicious, unusual or unnatural manner or where the body is to be cremated shall immediately notify the County Coroner and Medical Examiner."







Assistant will manage the agendas of the Budget Committee to allow elected officials/department heads to be heard should the need arise.

We are scheduling the large courtroom as usual for May & June on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 5:00 PM. Please see the attached Preliminary Budget Plan of Action for the anticipated meetings and corresponding agendas. These dates are subject to change. We will meet on an as-needed basis as determined by you, the Budget Committee Chairman.

We look forward to working together, so that we can and will prepare a budget that meets the needs of the citizens.
