P R O P O S A L

OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE TO THE COUNTY OF HAMBLLEN, TENNESSEE:

The DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION of the State of Tennessee, hereinafter "DEPARTMENT", proposes to construct a project in the COUNTY of HAMBLLEN, hereinafter "COUNTY", designated as State Project Number 32006-1226-14, that is described as S.R. 66 from North of I-81 at S.R. 341 in Jefferson County to S.R. 160 in Morristown, and the COUNTY agrees to cooperate with the DEPARTMENT as set forth in this proposal, so that the general highway program may be carried out in accordance with the intent of the General Assembly of the State.

Accordingly, the parties agree as follows:

1. That in the event any civil actions in inverse condemnation or for damages are instituted by reason of the DEPARTMENT, or its contractor, going upon the highway right-of-way and easements, and constructing said project in accordance with the plans and as necessary to make the completed project functional, the COUNTY will notify in writing the Attorney General of the State, whose address is 425 Fifth Avenue North, Nashville, Tennessee 37243, of the institution of each civil action, the complaint and all subsequent pleadings, within ten (10) days after the service of each of the same, under penalty of defending such actions and paying any judgments which result therefrom at its own expense.

2. The COUNTY will close or otherwise modify any of its roads or other public ways if indicated on the project plans, as provided by law.

3. The COUNTY will transfer or cause to be transferred to the DEPARTMENT without cost to it, all land owned by the COUNTY or by any of its instrumentalities as required for right-of-way or easement purposes, provided such land is being used or dedicated for road or other public way purposes.

4. Where privately, publicly or cooperatively owned utility lines, facilities and systems for producing, transmitting or distributing communications, power, electricity, light, heat, gas, oil, crude products, water, steam, waste, storm water not connected with highway drainage, and other similar commodities, including publicly owned facilities such as fire and police signal systems and street lighting systems are located within the right-of-way of any road or other public way owned by the COUNTY, or any of its instrumentalities, the COUNTY agrees that it will take action necessary to require the removal or adjustment of any of the above described facilities as would conflict with the construction of the project. But the foregoing may not be a duty of the COUNTY since it shall become operative only after the DEPARTMENT has been unsuccessful in its efforts to provide for said removals or adjustments for the benefit of the COUNTY.

The foregoing does not apply to those utility facilities which are owned by the COUNTY or one of its instrumentalities, it being understood that the COUNTY has the duty to relocate or adjust such facilities, if required, provided the COUNTY is notified to do so by the DEPARTMENT with detailed advice as to this duty of the COUNTY.

5. The COUNTY will maintain any frontage road to be constructed as part of the project.

6. After the project is completed and open to traffic, to the COUNTY will accept for jurisdiction and maintenance such parts of any existing DEPARTMENT highway to be replaced by the project.

7. The COUNTY will make no changes or alter any segment of a road on its road system that lies within the limits of the right-of-way acquired for any interchange to be constructed as part of the project and will not permit the installation or relocation of any utility facilities within the right-of-way of any such a segment of one of its roads without first obtaining the approval of the DEPARTMENT.

8. No provision hereof shall be construed as changing the maintenance responsibility of the COUNTY for such part of the project as may presently be on its highway, street, road or bridge system.

9. It is understood and agreed between the DEPARTMENT and the COUNTY that all traffic control signs for the control of traffic on a street under the jurisdiction of the COUNTY and located within the DEPARTMENT's right-of-way shall be maintained and replaced by the COUNTY.

10. When traffic control devices for the direction or warning of traffic, lighting of roadways or signing, or any of them, which are operated or function by the use of electric current are constructed or installed as part of the project, they will be furnished with electricity and maintained by the COUNTY.

11. If, as a result of acquisition and use of right-of-way for the project, any building improvements become in violation of a COUNTY setback/building line requirement, the COUNTY agrees to waive enforcement of the COUNTY setback/building line requirement and take other proper governmental action as necessary to accomplish such waiver.

12. The COUNTY will prohibit encroachments of any kind upon the right-of-way and easements for the project.

13. The COUNTY will prohibit the servicing of motor vehicles within the right-of-way and easements for the project.

14. The COUNTY will obtain the approval of the DEPARTMENT before authorizing parking on the right-of-way and easements for the project and before installing any device for the purpose of regulating the movement of traffic.

15. The DEPARTMENT will maintain the completed project if it is classified as full access control (i.e., a project which has no intersecting streets at grade), and it will maintain the pavement from curb to curb where curbs exist or the full width of the roadway where no curbs exist on non-access control projects. The COUNTY agrees to maintain other parts of non-access control projects.

16. If a sidewalk is constructed as a component of this project, the COUNTY shall be responsible for maintenance of the sidewalk and shall assume all liability for third-party claims for damages arising from its use of

the sidewalk or premises beyond the DEPARTMENT'S maintenance responsibilities as set forth in Section 15 of this Proposal.

17. When said project is completed, the COUNTY thereafter will not permit any additional median crossovers, the cutting of the pavement, curbs, gutters and sidewalks, by any person, firm, corporation or governmental agency, without first obtaining the approval of the DEPARTMENT.

18. The DEPARTMENT will acquire the right-of-way and easements, construct the project and defend any inverse condemnation or damage civil actions of which the Attorney General has received the notice and pleadings provided for herein.

19. The project plans hereinbefore identified by number and description are incorporated herein by reference and shall be considered a part of this proposal, including any revisions or amendments thereto, provided a copy of each is furnished the COUNTY.

20. The acceptance of this proposal shall be evidenced by the passage of an ordinance, or by other proper governmental action, which shall incorporate this proposal verbatim, or by reference thereto.

RESOLUTION UPHOLDING AND AFFIRMING THE FIRST AMENDMENT RIGHTS OF FREE SPEECH AND RIGHT TO PETITION THE GOVERNMENT FOR REDRESS OF GRIEVANCES AND TO CENSURE HAMBLLEN COUNTY COMMISSION CHAIRMAN HOWARD SHIPLEY FOR VIOLATION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS OF HAMBLLEN COUNTY CITIZENS


WHEREAS, the First Amendment to the U. S. Constitution embodies and protects the fundamental right of all Americans to freedom and speech and the right to petition the government for redress of grievances; and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Constitution, Article I, Section 19, further embodies and secures the basic principles of freedom of speech to the citizens of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Howard Shipley, Chairman of the Hamblen County Commission ("Commission") both abused and exceeded his authority and power as chairman of the Commission and infringed upon and restricted the First Amendment Rights of citizens, including the right to freedom of speech and the right to petition the government for redress of grievances, by issuing the following directives and taking the following actions on October 22, 2020:

1. Arbitrarily, capriciously, and with no basis in law or fact, determining that the wearing of COAG (Citizens for Open and Accountable Government) shirts to the October 22, 2020, public meeting of the Commission would be prohibited or conditioned upon the wearer turning the shirt inside-out prior to being allowed into the meeting room--despite the fact that Shipley had allowed COAG shirts to be worn at Committee and Commission meetings for three months prior to October 22, 2020; despite the fact that Shipley had never publicly stated an objection to the shirts; despite the fact that Shipley never claimed or asserted in a public meeting that the COAG shirts violated any commission rule.
2. Using and directing law enforcement personnel of the Hamblen County Sheriff's Department to require that individuals wearing COAG shirts and entering the Courthouse to attend the October 22, 2020, public meeting of the Commission turn the COAG shirts inside-out before being allowed to proceed on to the meeting;
3. By the above directive and actions, imposing an impermissible and unconstitutional clothing requirement involving political speech protected by the First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution and further protected by the Tennessee Constitution including Article I, Section 19 upon at least six citizens of Hamblen County.



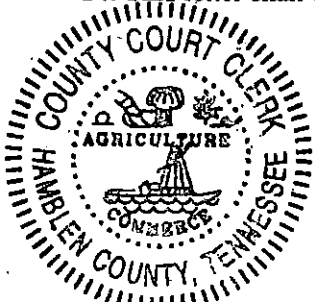



Statement by Howard Shipley, Chairman of the Hamblen County Commission


1. I am Chairman of the Hamblen County Commission ("Commission") having been elected to that position by vote of the Commission on September 24, 2020.
2. On or about October 22, 2020, I directed that the Hamblen County deputy or deputies monitoring the entrance to the Hamblen County Courthouse require that individuals wearing a COAG shirt (Citizens for Open and Accountable Government) turn the shirt inside-out before proceeding upstairs to the commission meeting over which I was to preside.
3. The commission has no rule concerning clothing or shirts in general and has no specific rule prohibiting political statements on shirts worn to commission meetings.
4. COAG shirts had been worn to commission and/or committee meetings since July 23, 2020, and I said nothing, took no action, and did not request courthouse security personnel to take any action or direct that COAG shirts be turned inside-out at any time prior to the October 22, 2020, meeting.
5. As Commission Chair, I have no authority to direct that county law enforcement tell citizens to turn their shirts inside-out before entering the Courthouse to attend a public meeting of the commission.
6. I exceeded my authority in directing the actions of county law enforcement personnel on October 22, 2020.
7. I also exceeded my authority in claiming to be enforcing a rule against "personal, impertinent, profane, or slanderous remarks" when I directed that COAG shirts be turned inside-out before the individuals were allowed to attend the public meeting.
8. The First Amendment to the Constitution of the United States and the Tennessee Constitution (Article I, Section 19) supersede any and all powers that I may have as Commission Chair.
9. The U.S. Constitution and the Tennessee Constitution prevent government at all levels from wrongly prohibiting the exercise of the right of free speech and the right to petition the government.
10. I wrongfully prohibited the exercise of freedom of speech and the right to petition the government when I directed that deputies stop individuals wearing a COAG shirt at the Courthouse door and tell the individuals to turn their shirts inside-out before being allowed to come to the public meeting.

11. I acknowledge that I exceeded my authority in multiple ways on October 22, 2020, and that I violated the constitutional rights of citizens on that day.
12. I do not want to cost Hamblen County taxpayers money in defending a lawsuit that could be brought due to my actions violating the constitutional rights of any citizen.
13. My actions deserve and I will accept a vote of censure by this body. Should the commission decline to approve censure, I will resign my position as Chairman.
14. This letter shall be placed in the minutes of the County Commission.

I have been on the Commission for many years now and the jail has been a thorn in Hamblen County's side for all of those years, even before I was elected. We have spent quite a few years now trying to come up with a solution. While not all will agree with the solution, it is a solution that is now moving forward to a resolution. The finances for this jail are being closely monitored and will be closely monitored all the way to completion. Every person on this commission has worked diligently and with integrity on this project. I find it disheartening when I see social media posts or comments being made that give half-truths or slanderous remarks about the commission members or the commission body.
