**RESOLUTION FIXING THE TAX LEVY IN  
HAMBLLEN COUNTY, TENNESSEE  
FOR YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2003  
AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2004**

SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Hamblen County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session on this 21<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2003 that the combined tax rate for in Hamblen County, Tennessee for the year beginning July 1, 2003 shall be \$2.06 on each \$100 of taxable property inside the corporate limits of the City of Morristown and \$2.36 on each \$100 of taxable property outside the corporate limits of the City of Morristown, which is to provide for revenue for each of the following funds and otherwise conform to the following levies:

General Purpose School	1.30	1.30
Solid Waste/Sanitation	.00	.30
Total	2.06	2.36

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby levied a gross receipts business tax provided by law. The proceeds of the gross receipts tax herein levied shall accrue to the General Fund except for the first \$1,600 that is appropriated to the Highway Fund.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is levied a motor vehicle privilege tax as provided by law. The proceeds of the \$ 27 motor vehicle privilege tax herein levied shall accrue \$14 to General Fund and \$13 to the General Purpose School Fund.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is levied a hotel/motel occupancy tax as provided by law. The proceeds of the hotel/motel occupancy tax herein levied shall accrue to the Cherokee Park Fund for the specific purpose of capital improvements to Cherokee Park.

SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is levied a local option sales tax as provided by law. The first 50% of the sales tax shall accrue to the General Purpose School Fund and the second half shall accrue to the Solid Waste Sanitation Fund.

SECTION 6. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution will take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This resolution shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.
