RESOLUTION FOR LEVYING AN ADDITIONAL SALES AND USE TAX

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Hamblen County, Tennessee, as follows:

- **Section 1.** The Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Hamblen County, Tennessee, imposing a local sales and use tax as authorized under the provisions of *Tennessee Code Annotated* §§ 67-6-701 et seq., adopted by the County at a regular meeting held on June 16, 1986, is amended to levy a local sales and use tax at a rate of 9.75%, not to exceed the maximum percentage as provided for in the "1963 Local Option Revenue Act," *Tennessee Code Annotated* § 67-6-702, as amended, except as limited or modified by statute.
- **Section 2.** If a majority of those voting in the election required by *Tennessee Code Annotated* § 67-6-706 vote for the increase in the tax imposed by this Resolution, collection of the increased tax levied by this Resolution shall begin on the first day of July, 2009 (the beginning of the next fiscal year for the City of Morristown).
- **Section 3.** The Department of Revenue of the State of Tennessee shall collect the additional tax imposed by this Resolution concurrent with the collection of the state tax and the local tax being collected for Hamblen County, in accordance with rules and regulations promulgated by the Department.
- **Section 4.** The Hamblen County Trustee is authorized to contract with the Department of Revenue for the collection of the additional tax imposed by this Resolution, and to provide in the contract that the Department may deduct from the tax collected a reasonable amount or percentage as provided by statute to cover the expenses of the administration and collection of the tax as provided for in *Tennessee Code Annotated* § 67-6-710.
- **Section 5.** In the event the tax is collected by the Department of Revenue, suits for the recovery of any tax illegally assessed or collected shall be brought against the Tennessee Commissioner of Revenue and the Hamblen County Trustee.
- Section 6. That said referendum shall be held simultaneously with the regular election on November 4, 2008.
- **Section 7.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon the adoption of this Resolution by the Hamblen County Board of Commissioners

CAPITAL OUTLAY NOTES*

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF

HAMBLEN COUNTY, TENNESSEE, AUTHORIZING
THE ISSUANCE, SALE, AND PAYMENT OF FOUR-YEAR CAPITAL OUTLAY NOTES

NOT TO EXCEED \$475,000

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of Hamblen County, Tennessee (the Local Government) has determined that it is necessary and desirable to provide funds for the following public safety project (the "Project"): "2008 Sheriff's Fleet".

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has determined that the Project will promote or provide a Traditional governmental activity or otherwise fulfill a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Parts I, IV, and VI of Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated (the "Act"), local governments in Tennessee are authorized to finance the cost of this Project through the issuance and sale of interest bearing capital outlay notes upon the approval of the State Director of Local Finance; and WHEREAS, the Governing Body finds that it is advantageous to the Local Government to authorize the issuance of capital outlay notes to finance the cost of the Project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of Hamblen County, Tennessee, as follows:

Section 1. That, for the purpose of providing funds to finance the cost of the Project in and for the Local Government, the Chief Executive Officer of the Local Government is hereby authorized in accordance with the terms of this resolution to issue and sell interest-bearing capital outlay notes in a principal amount not to exceed _Four Hundred Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (\$_475,000_) (the "Notes") at either a competitive public sale or at a private negotiated sale upon approval of the State Director of Local Finance pursuant to the terms, provisions, and conditions permitted by law. The Notes shall be designated "2008 Sheriff's Fleet Capital Outlay Note", shall be numbered serially from 1 upwards; shall be dated as of the date of issuance; shall be in denomination (s) as agreed upon with the purchaser; shall be sold at not less than 99% of par value and accrued interest; and shall bear interest at a rate or rates not to exceed six percent (6%) per annum, and in no event shall the rate exceed the legal limit provided by law.

Section 2*. That, the Notes shall mature not later than four (4) years after the date of issuance and that the Notes and any extension or renewal notes shall not exceed the reasonably expected economic life of the Project, which is hereby certified by the Governing Body to be at least four years. Provided, however, that each year the Notes are outstanding, one-fourth (1/4), but in no event not less than one-ninth (1/9), of the original principal amount of the Notes shall mature without renewal but subject to prior redemption.

^{*}Hamblen County Government intends to pay the debt from General Debt Service

Section 3. That, the Notes shall be subject to redemption at the option of the Local Government, in whole or in part, at any time, at the principal amount and accrued interest to the date of redemption, without a premium, or, if sold at par, with or without a premium of not exceeding one percent (1%) of the principal amount.

Section 4. That, the Notes shall be direct general obligations of the Local Government, for which the punctual payment of the principal and interest on the notes, the full faith and credit of the Local Government is irrevocably pledged and the Local Government hereby pledges its taxing power as to all taxable property in the Local Government for the purpose of providing funds for the payment of principal of and interest on the Notes. The Governing Body of the Local Government hereby authorizes the levy and collection of a special tax on all taxable property of the Local government over and above all other taxes authorized by the Local government to create a sinking fund to retire the Notes with interest as they mature in an amount necessary for that purpose.

Section 5. That, the Notes shall be executed in the name of the Local Government and bear the Manual signature of the chief executive officer of the Local Government and the manual signature of the County Mayor, David W. Purkey with the Local Government seal affixed thereon; and shall be payable as to principal and interest at the office of the County Clerk, Linda Wilder of the Local Government or the paying agent duly appointed by the Local Government. Proceeds of the Notes shall be deposited with the Trustee, Bill Brittain of the Local Government and shall be paid out for the purpose of financing the Project pursuant to this Resolution and as required by law.

Section 6. That, the Notes will be issued in fully registered form and that at all times during which any Notes remains outstanding and unpaid, the Local Government or its agent shall keep or cause to be kept at its office a note register, if held by an agent of the Local Government, shall at all times be open for inspection by the Local Government or any duly authorized officer of the Local Government. Each Note shall have the qualities and incidents of a negotiable instrument and shall be transferable only upon the note register kept by the Local Government or its agent, by the registered owner of the Note in person or by the registered owner's attorney duly authorized in writing, upon presentation and surrender to the Local Government or its agent together with a written instrument of transfer satisfactory to the Local Government duly executed by the registered owner of the registered owner's duly authorized attorney. Upon the transfer of any such Note, the Local Government shall issue in the name of the transferee a new registered note or notes of the same aggregate principal amount and maturity as the surrendered Notes. The Local Government shall not be obligated to make any such Note transfer during the fifteen (15) days next preceding an interest payment date of the Notes or, in the case of any redemption of the Notes, during the forty-five (45) days next preceding the date of redemption.

Section 7. That, the Notes shall be in substantially the form attached hereto and shall recite that the Notes are issued pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated. Section 8. That, the Notes shall be sold only after the receipt of the written approval of the State Director of Local Finance for the sale of the Notes.

Section 9. That, the notes are hereby designated as qualified tax-exempt obligations for purpose of Section 265(b) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

Section 10. That, after the sale of the Notes, and for each year that any of the notes are outstanding, the Local Government shall prepare an annual budget in a form consistent with accepted governmental standards and as approved by the State Director of Local Finance (the "Director".) The budget shall be kept balanced during the life of the notes. The annual budget shall be submitted to the Director immediately upon its adoption; however, it shall not become the official budget for the fiscal year until such budget is approved by the Director in accordance with Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated (the "Statutes".) If the Director determines that the budget does not comply with the Statutes, the Governing Body shall adjust its estimates or make additional tax levies sufficient to comply with the Statutes, or as directed by the Director.

Section 11. That, if any of the Notes shall remain unpaid at the end of four (4) years from the issue date, then the unpaid Notes shall be renewed or extended as permitted by law, or retired from the funds of the Local Government or be converted into bonds pursuant to Chapter 11 of Title 9 of the Tennessee Code Annotated, or any other law, or be otherwise liquidated as approval by the State Director of Local Finance.

Section 12. That, all orders or resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed insofar as such conflict exists and this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
