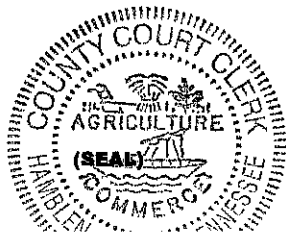

ELECTION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM  
SOFTWARE MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 1<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2006, by and between the County of Hamblen, Tennessee, acting by and through the Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as the "County", and MicroVote General Corporation, an Indiana corporation, hereinafter referred to as "MicroVote".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County desires to contract for election management system software maintenance for the MicroVote Election Management System (MEMS) software, and WHEREAS, MicroVote has expressed a willingness to provide those services.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties hereto mutually covenant and agree as follows:

1. MicroVote agrees to provide the following services:

- a. Unlimited software upgrades: Upgrades and release notes will be made to conform with state requirements and will be sent once approved by the State Election Commission. These upgrades will also comply with Federal Election Commission standards and any changes with these standards.
- b. Technical Support: 24 hour technical support will be available to include telephone support for "help desk" level inquiries. In field technical support will be available, if needed, on demand.
- c. Version Control: MicroVote will control all software versions and will require County to install the most recent upgrade to ensure versions throughout the United States.

2. The parties hereto agree that County shall pay to MicroVote for the work performed under this agreement as set forth above, the sum of One Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1650.00) per year. MicroVote understands and agrees that this agreement is contingent upon the approval and appropriations of monies by the Hamblen County Board of Commissioners. County agrees to pay the said fee within sixty (60) days of the date of the invoice.

3. The term of this agreement shall be for a period of one (1) year to commence on the 1st day of January 2006.

4. No portion of the work under this agreement shall be sublet, assigned, or otherwise disposed of, except with the written consent of County. Consent to sublet, assign or otherwise dispose of any portion of the work under this agreement shall not be construed to relieve MicroVote from any responsibility for the fulfillment of this agreement.

5. MicroVote specifically agrees that in performance of the services herein enumerated that they will comply with any and all state, federal and local statutes, ordinances, and regulations.

6. Nothing under this agreement shall be construed to give any rights or benefits in this agreement to anyone other than MicroVote and County, and all duties and responsibilities pursuant to this agreement will be for the sole and exclusive benefit of MicroVote and County and not for the benefit of any other party.

7. The County, insofar as authorized by law, binds itself and its successors, and MicroVote binds its successors, and assignees to the other party of this agreement with respect to all covenants of this agreement.

**RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE RECENT RATE INCREASE IMPOSED BY CABLE OPERATORS FOR CABLE TELEVISION SERVICES IN HAMBLLEN COUNTY, PROMOTING REGULATION BY THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS, AND ENCOURAGING OTHER CITY AND COUNTY GOVERNING BODIES TO DO THE SAME.**

**WHEREAS**, cable television service providers operating under a non-exclusive franchise from Hamblen County to maintain and operate cable television systems in Hamblen County, have announced an increase in the rates charged for cable television services, and

**WHEREAS**, Hamblen County Legislative Body wishes to encourage the United States Congress to resume strict regulation of the cable television industry so as to prevent cable television providers, both locally and nationwide, from overcharging for their services.

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Legislative Body of Hamblen County, Tennessee that:

1. This Body strongly opposes the recently announced rate increases imposed by cable operators and encourages other City and County governing bodies in areas served by cable operators to do the same.

2. This Body encourages the United States Congress to enact legislation regulating cable television providers nationwide in such a fashion as to prevent them from making excessive charges for their services.



**RESOLUTION-CONVICTED SEX OFFENDERS DISTANCE**

Motion by Bobby Reinhardt, seconded by Dennis Alvis to approve the following resolution to limit sex offenders within 2500 feet of schools and childcare facilities.

**RESOLUTION OF THE HAMBLEN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
TO LIMIT SEX OFFENDERS WITHIN TWENTY-FIVE HUNDRED (2500)  
FEET OF SCHOOLS AND CHILDCARE FACILITIES**

**WHEREAS**, the Tennessee Legislature has, by adoption of *Tennessee Code Annotated* § 40-39-211, prohibited certain sex offenders whose victims were children from living or working within one thousand (1,000) feet of a school or childcare facility; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the sense of the Hamblen County Board of Commissioners that this distance is inadequate for the protection of minors from sex offenders who prey upon them; and

**WHEREAS**, it is further the sense of the Hamblen County Board of Commissioners that the goals of the bill would be better served by increasing the distance between the residence and work addresses of such offenders and school and childcare facilities from one thousand (1,000) feet to twenty-five hundred (2500) feet; and

**WHEREAS**, Hamblen County Commissioner Bobby Reinhardt desires to sponsor just such a resolution; **NOW**

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Hamblen County Board of Commissioners meeting in its regular session on February 23, 2006 resolves as follows:

1. No sexual offender, as defined by the provisions of *T.C.A.* § 40-39-202(16) or violent sexual offender, as defined by the provisions of *T.C.A.* § 40-39-202(24), whose victim was a minor and who is subject to the sexual offender registration laws set forth in Title 40, Chapter 39 of the *Tennessee Code Annotated*, shall knowingly establish a primary or secondary residence or any living accommodation, or knowingly accept employment, within two thousand five hundred feet (2,500') of the property line on which any public school, private or parochial school, licensed daycare center or any other child care facility is located.
2. Violators of this Resolution shall be subject to the penalties set forth in *Tennessee Code Annotated* § 5-1-121, with each day's violation constituting a separate offense.
