# RESOLUTION BY HAMBLEN COUNTY, TENNESSEE, REGARDING THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S PROPOSED U.S. HIGHWAY 25E INTERCHANGE

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Department of Transportation ("TDOT"), has revealed long-range plans to transform a portion of U. S. Highway 25E to an interstate-like, control-access roadway; and

WHEREAS, said long-range plans would close access to Highway 25E from Wilson Hale Road, Spencer Hale Road, Jacobs Road, Highway 343 and Vineyard Road and eliminate access to Highway 25E for certain residential and business property owners abutting Highway 25E; and

WHEREAS, said long-range plans have been proposed without input from Hamblen County governmental officials or the local residents and business owners most effected by said proposed long-range plans; and

WHEREAS, at a public meeting held by TDOT for the purpose of presenting the proposed road improvements and the receipt of comments from affected Hamblen County residents, opposition to the proposed road improvements was almost unanimous; and

# A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

This policy is made and entered into on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2005 by the Hamblen County Legislative Body, hereinafter referred to as the "Legislative Body" and is intended to be binding on all the emergency services and response agencies of Hamblen County Government.

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2004 the President of the United States signed into law the Intelligence Reform Act of 2004, hereinafter referred to as "the Act", which contained several recommendations for the minimum training requirements of all first responders; and

WHEREAS, "the Act" formally created the National Incident Management System (NIMS) and recognized it as the cornerstone of unified command training for all emergency personnel in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of Homeland Security has created a timeline for nationwide adoption of NIMS; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security, through the Office of Domestic Preparedness, has made NIMS compliance a requirement for the application of any federal homeland security funds; and

WHEREAS, Hamblen County wishes to comply with the federal Homeland Security Strategy; and

WHEREAS, this system will provide a consistent nationwide approach for federal, state, local, and tribal governments to work effectively and efficiently together to prepare for, prevent, respond to, and recover from domestic incidents, regardless of cause, size, or complexity; NOW

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Hamblen County Legislative Body hereby adopts the National Incident Management System and requests the Director of the Morristown-Hamblen Emergency Management Agency send a copy of this resolution to the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency in order to show proof of compliance.
