WHEREAS, the adoption of these codes is done to facilitate proper inspection activities by Hamblen County, Tennessee relating to construction and maintenance of public buildings within Hamblen County, Tennessee and relating to public safety, health and general welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY the Hamblen County Board of Commissioners that the following codes are hereby adopted by reference as though they were copied herein fully:

NORTH CAROLINA STATE HANDICAPPED CODE – 1991

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY Hamblen County, Tennessee that any matters in said codes which are contrary to existing Resolutions of Hamblen County, Tennessee shall prevail and, to that extent any existing Resolutions to the contrary are hereby repealed in that respect only.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that within said Codes, when reference is made to the duties of a certain official named therein, that designated official of Hamblen County, Tennessee who has duties corresponding to those of the named official in said Code shall be deemed to be the responsible official insofar as enforcing the provisions of said Code are concerned.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
