Whereas, The Bob Harbison Memorial Hall of Honor for Hamblen County was first presented in 1997 by Tina Swatzell Harbison and family in memory of W.R. "Bob" Harbison, and

Whereas, Bob passed away March 11, 1997 after a nine-year struggle with the debilitating effects of a stroke, and

Whereas, prior to his illness, Bob was a Presbyterian Minister and educator, and was also responsible for starting the Adult Education Program in Hamblen County; he also worked for the Lakeway Center for the Handicapped and served as a member of the Board of Directors of the Tennessee Protection and Advocacy Persons with Disabilities, and

Whereas, Bob became totally committed to the advancement and protection of the rights of people with disabilities, and was recognized in 1996 by the Tennessee Nursing Home Association as Who's Who in Tennessee Nursing Homes for his contributions to adult education and to those with disabilities, and

Whereas, other future plans include providing education and information about disabilities to the general public, and

Whereas, the Hall of Honor is an annual recognition of the accomplishments of people who not only overcame their disability, but also contributed positively to their community, and

Whereas, each year a new group of people will be added to the county's elite group of honorees, and

Whereas, the mission of the Hall of Honor is to help people see in others true abilities rather than disabilities, and similarities rather than differences, and

Whereas, this year's Inductees will be honored at a banquet on November 8, 2001 at Morristown-Hamblen Healthcare System,

Now, therefore, be it resolved, on this the 29th day of October, 2001, that the Hamblen County Legislative Body does hereby designate November 8, 2001 as Disability Awareness Day in Hamblen County, Tennessee.
