


RETIRE TENNESSEE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development is committed to assisting Tennessee communities with the promotion of their cities and towns as a destination and possible permanent residence of out-of-state retiring persons; and

WHEREAS, the Retire Tennessee Program afford participating communities the opportunity to promote and market nationally their community with the state and other Tennessee communities; and



AND THE NATIONWIDE NO-TEXTING-WHILE-DRIVING MOVEMENT**

WHEREAS, the Tennessee County Services Association (TCSA) holds the health and safety of its teenagers and adults as a chief concern; and

WHEREAS, through ItCanWait.com, Facebook, text-to-pledge, tweet-to-pledge and events, more than 1.5 million people have committed to never text and drive; and

WHEREAS, 98 percent of American commuters know sending a text or email while driving is not safe; and

WHEREAS, nearly 50 percent of commuters text while behind the wheel; and

WHEREAS, more than 40 percent of commuters who text while driving reported the activity as being a habit; and

WHEREAS, a Virginia Tech study showed those who send text messages while driving are 23 times more likely to crash; and

WHEREAS, a driver that sends a text message while driving not only jeopardizes his or her safety, but also the safety of passengers, pedestrians, and other drivers.

County Mayor's Report August 12, 2013

Jail/Justice Center Needs Assessment RFQ/RFP -

The RFQ/RFP was released August 1st. It was advertised in Knoxville and Morristown newspapers, sent to more than ten firms on our distribution list and posted to the County's website. Tours of the jail/justice center are scheduled for next week. The deadline to submit a proposal is September 6th.

Ambulance Service Regulations -

County attorney Chris Capps is revising the proposal that was presented by Morristown-Hamblen EMS based on information he has received from CTAS. The revision will be presented to the Public Safety Committee in September after further review by Commissioner Phillips, EMA Director Bell and me.

Civil Service Board -

Kirk Wyss has accepted for one year the position of CSB chairman.

Whitesburg Sewer Project -

Work is underway to install the E-1 pumps. The system connection to the manhole behind Whitesburg Elementary School was completed two weeks ago. The City is being updated on the progress of the project by the engineer. The completion deadline is September 30th.

Juvenile Court Services Update -

The Juvenile Court Services office has been reorganized as recommended in the Judge Study Report of February 2013. The Director continues to report to the County Mayor while all staff now reports to the Director. Juvenile Judge Mindy Seals agreed to the reorganization. An updated version of the juvenile services operations software is being installed.

Courthouse Lawn Flag Pole Project -

The project has been delayed until the spring of 2014 to allow the Sons of the Revolution plenty of time to raise the money to pay for the project. The state's Tourism Development department has approved the handicapped accessibility parking for the Battle of Morristown marker that is part of the project. The State is funding the Battle of Morristown marker which will be part of the State's Civil War Trail.

Cherokee Park Update -

The East TN State Fair is this week at Cherokee Park. Everything is in place for a good event.

Website Redesign Update -

The unveiling of the redesigned Hamblen County Government website has been moved to after Labor Day.

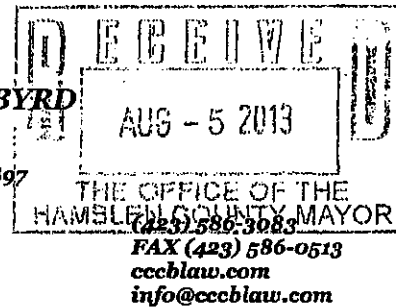
Animal Control/Animal Shelter Study Committee -
